

## Economic Impacts (2013)

### Agricultural and related industries generate

**1,575** jobs (14.8% of total) in Washington County.

**\$63.5** million in revenues.

**9.3%** contribution to gross regional product.

It is estimated that for every **\$1** invested in agricultural research and extension, there is a return of **\$20** to the community.
