

## Economic Impacts (2013)

### Agricultural and related industries generate

**8,393** jobs (16.9% of total) in Citrus County.

**\$338.4** million in revenues.

**8.3%** contribution to gross regional product.

It is estimated that for every **\$1** invested in agricultural research and extension, there is a return of **\$20** to the community.
