Google Chrome does not support the following features:

Known issues:

- When you use certain browser extensions (such as Babylon Translator), pushbuttons may not work in browser applications.
 Solution: Deactivate the relevant extensions in the Chrome settings.
- Plug-ins (for example, using Microsoft Silverlight or Adobe Reader) may cause problems.
- Deleting favorites from the Portal does not always work.
- Scroll Bars not displayed properly in some scenarios
- In the Universal Work List (UWL) the refresh Button is not displayed properly
- In some tables, the filter value popup are not removed completely after closing in the BEX Web Analyzer
