OWLS RETURN TO NCAA ACTION AS C-USA CHAMPIONS

Efe Ustundag's 26th ranked Rice Owls return to NCAA action for the first time since 2011 but the 11th time in school history when they participate in the Ft. Worth Regional, May 13-14. The Owls (23-7) open action with a rematch with #36 LSU at 10 a.m. on Friday. The winner will face the winner of host and national #4 seed TCU and Jackson State at 1 p.m. on Saturday for the right to advance to the NCAA Championship in Tulsa, Oklahoma May 20-24.

CAREER RECORDS

The Owls have a 6-10 record in the NCAA team championship and have a 5-5 mark in the round of 64. They are 6-10 vs. LSU, including a thrilling 4-3 win at the George R. Brown Tennis Center on January 31. They are 1-1 vs. the Tigers in NCAA team competition, all in Baton Rouge. Rice won 4-0 in the 2004 regional final to earn the schools only advancement to the Sweet 16 since the NCAA adopted the current format in 1977. Rice is 10-29 vs. TCU, including a 4-1 loss in Ft. Worth on April 1. The Owls won the only previous meeting in the NCAA championship, taking a 4-3 win in Austin in 2008. Rice has never faced Jackson St.

MORE ON THE OWLS

The Owls 23 wins this year are their most since the 2004 squad finished 24-4 on their way to a trip to the Sweet 16. It's the fourth time since 1980 that Rice has topped 20 dual wins (21-9 in 2001, 20-8 in 2003 and 24-4 in 2004). The Owls current No. 26 ranking is their highest heading into an NCAA tournament since the 2008 squad was ranked 22nd prior to the tourney and finished 24th.

POSTSEASON HONORS

After capturing Rice's first C-USA title since 2010, Rice men's tennis head coach Efe Ustundag was named Conference USA Men's Tennis Coach of the Year while Jake Hansen was tabbed C-USA Freshman of the Year and Jamie Malik and Adam Gustafsson earned Double of the Championship honors in voting by conference coaches. Gustafsson and Tommy Bennett were named All C-USA first team, while Hansen, Malik and David Warren were named to the second team. Bennett and Warren, who are currently ranked 28th in the nation, earned first team honors in doubles. Gustafsson and Malik were named to the second team.

TOURNAMENT TESTED

Rice played 12 times against teams who earned berths in the NCAA, posting a 5-7 record. The Owls defeated LSU, SMU, Texas Tech, Tulane and UT-Arlington while dropping matches vs. Lamar, Northwestern, San Diego, Stanford, TCU, Texas and Texas A&M.

Rice has won 23 of 30 doubles points this season, including the last six consecutive, and the Owls are 22-1 when winning the point and 1-6 when losing two of three doubles. They dropped the doubles point before rallying to beat LSU and saw Stanford rally to win after the Owls took the opening point.

1. JAMIE MALIK, SO.

Finished 7-12 on the year, primarily playing at No. 1 (5-9)... Top win of the year came in a 6-2, 7-6 (6) win over #48 Hunter Johnson of SMU... C-USA Men's Tennis Athlete of the Week for January 19 after an unbeaten opening weekend... Combined with Adam Gustafsson to go 5-5 in doubles and earn Oustanding Doubles of the C-USA Championship... Malik and Adam Gustafsson delivered three standout doubles performances to spark the Owls in each round of the C-USA Championship... Dropped only four games over three matches, including a 6-0 win in the title match to finish first...Top win was a 7-6 (12) win over Texas Tech's #57 Alex Sendegeya/Bjorn Thomson to secure the doubles in 4-3 win over #9 Tech. Rice's first win over a top ten opponent since 2006.

2. TOMMY BENNETT, JR.

Returned to action after sitting out 2015 with an injury and led the Owls to their first C-USA title since 2010... Finished 9-9 in singles (2-3 at No. 1; 7-6 at No. 2) and vaulted into the national top 30 in doubles with David Warren... First doubles team to qualify for NCAA's since 2008... 16-5 overall in doubles, 7-2 with Warren... Named C-USA Men's Tennis Athlete of the Week on February 2 for his match-clinching victory over LSU's 78th ranked Justin Butsch to give the Owls a 4-3 win... Teamed with Warren to win consecutive doubles matches vs. teams ranked 41st, 24th and 17th.
