Admission as a Postbaccalaureate Student

Guidelines and Requirements

Postbaccalaureate applicants should coordinate with the department in which they desire admission before submitting the application and non-refundable application fee.

Admission to Postbaccalaureate Studies

Postbaccalaureate study is for students who already have received a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution. The university has limited space available for postbaccalaureate studies. Applicants should communicate their intentions with their proposed program before they apply.

Options for Postbaccalaureate Studies

Applicants must select a specific purpose; options are limited and are not available in all programs.

- Teacher Certification
- Prerequisites for graduate study

When to Apply

Applications are accepted one year in advance.

All applicants should verify their program's deadline with the appropriate department.

■ The Self-Reported GPA Computation Worksheet must be completed.

Application and Fee

Mail the application and \$30 non-refundable application fee to the University of Florida, Office of Admissions, PO Box 2946, Gainesville, FL 32627-2946.

■ Transcript Requirements

Applicants must ensure that official transcripts are sent from each higher-education institution attended to the University of Florida, Office of Admissions, PO Box 114000, Gainesville, FL 32611-4000. Students who have previously attended the university do not need to request University of Florida transcripts. Applicants who currently are enrolled at another institution must send updated transcripts as soon as grades for that term are available.

■ Test Score Requirements

Proficiency in the English language is required of applicants from countries (including Puerto Rico) where English is not the official language. These applicants must submit official scores from the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), International English Language Testing System (IELTS), or the Michigan English Language Assessment Battery (MELAB). This requirement may be waived if you have been enrolled in a degree seeking program for one academic year (in a country where English is the official language) prior to your anticipated term of enrollment at UF. Official test scores must be sent to the University of Florida, Office of Admissions, PO Box 114000, 201 Criser Hall, Gainesville, FL 32611-4000.

Admission notification will be mailed to the applicant directly from the department.

Applicants for postbaccalaureate study at the University of Florida are required to compute their college-level junior and senior year grade point average, unless your institution uses a non-traditional grading system. This GPA will be verified by the university. An accurate self-reported GPA will help to expedite the processing of your application.

Please use these guidelines:

- Junior and senior level study refers specifically to <u>all coursework taken after the term</u> during which you earned 60 semester hours or 90 quarter hours. Typically, these courses are taken in the third and fourth years of study. This coursework continues until you graduate with a baccalaureate degree.
- If you apply to graduate school before you have graduated, your calculation of grade point average (GPA) would continue up to but not include the current term of enrollment. The current term is considered a term in progress.
- This GPA calculation includes all coursework completed. Do not include courses that were dropped or courses that do not award letter
 grades (e.g., satisfactory / unsatisfactory grades). However, if you have repeated a course, both grades must be included.
- When the GPA is computed, the result is truncated after the first decimal place.

Converting quarter hours to semester hours:

- If all hours were earned at institutions using only quarter hours, you do not have to convert to semester hours but may use quarter system credit hours to complete the calculation.
- Do not combine quarter credit hours with semester credit hours; instead, convert quarter hours to semester hours using the following equations:

1 quarter hour = 2/3 semester hour OR 3 quarter hours = 2 semester hours

For example: 24 quarter hours $x \frac{2}{3} = 16$ semester hours.

Florida Residency Declaration for Tuition Purposes

continued →

A Florida "resident for tuition purposes" is a person who has, or a dependent person whose parent or legal guardian has, established and maintained legal residency in Florida for at least twelve (12) consecutive months preceding the first day of classes of the term for which Florida residency is sought. Residence in Florida must be a bona fide domicile rather than for the purpose of maintaining a residence incident to enrollment at an institution of higher education. To qualify as a Florida resident for tuition purposes, you must be a U.S. citizen, a foreign national in a nonimmigrant visa classification that grants you the legal ability to establish a bona fide domicile in the United States, a permanent resident alien, parolee, asylee, Cuban-Haitian entrant, or legal alien granted indefinite stay by the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services. Other persons not meeting the twelve-month legal residence requirements may be classified as Florida residents for tuition purposes only if they fall within one of the limited special categories authorized by the Florida Legislature pursuant to section 1009.21, Florida Statutes. All other persons are ineligible for classification as a Florida "resident for tuition purposes." Living in or attending school in Florida will not, in itself, establish legal residence. Students who depend upon out-of-state parents for support are presumed to be legal residents of the same state as their parents. Residency for tuition purposes requires the establishment of legal ties to the state of Florida. A student must verify that the student has broken ties to other states if the student or, in the case of a dependent student, his or her parent has moved from another state.
