In total, 942 students completed the survey:

$65 \%$ said adults at their school know their name.
$55 \%$ said their school is clean.

## Parents

In total, 233 parents completed the survey:
$93 \%$ said they feel welcome at their school.
31\% said they talk with the teacher about their child's schoolwork.

60\% said that the school's professional development addresses their students' needs.
