
STAFF

From the West, South West



FEES

The total cost for the camp, which includes five days of instruction, meals, lodging, swimming, and camp t-shirt, is \$295 per camper. (There is a \$25 discount for siblings of Cal U employees.) Soccer balls can be purchased for \$30.

HOUSING

All campers, as well as the staff, will be housed in college residence halls. Entry doors are locked and secured 24 hours a day. Campers must use their keys to gain access



to the residence halls. Pillow and linens are not provided. All rooms are air-conditioned and have private bathrooms.

LOST KEY POLICY

Campers who do not turn in their room key at camp dismissal will be charged the lock change fee of \$50-\$240. **This must be paid at departure.** For security reasons, lock changes must be made immediately before the next group arrives. Mailing keys in after check out is not acceptable. There will be no exceptions.

FIELDS USED AT CAL

A variety of fields are utilized for the weeks of camp in Cal. The main site is Phillipsburg Soccer Complex, a state-of-the-art soccer specific

facility. Only minutes from the residence halls, this complex offers a professional level turf field and a very high quality training facility. There are also several smaller grass complexes located at Roadman Park that



will also be used. Adamson Stadium also offers a sport turf field. Both are located right off campus and are convenient and well maintained.

OTHER FACILITIES

Cal U offers a swimming pool, tennis courts, dining room, movie theater, video games, ping-pong and pool tables.


