The Steering Committee includes representatives from the campus administration, the Academic Senate, the ASUC, and the Graduate Assembly.
	The Berkeley campus has been fully accredited since 1949 and its accreditation was reaffirmed most recently in 2004. WASC's standards for accreditation are shared by UC Berkeley and are intended to ensure that institutions of higher education act with integrity, yield high quality educational outcomes, and are committed to continuous improvement.
	As the accreditation process unfolds, the Steering Committee and its supporting contributors will engage many members of the campus community and will keep the community at large informed of its progress. They will also be calling on members of the campus community to contribute to the campus self-study effort, and I would appreciate your full cooperation if you are contacted.
