As Co-Editors in Chief of the Journal of Ecohydraulics, we would like to invite participants of the ISE2016 in Melbourne to consider this journal for high quality manuscripts covering all ecohydraulic topics. Full papers submitted from the ISE2016 will face a peer review process aimed at ensuring the high quality of the manuscripts and, if accepted, will be published in some early issues of the Journal, starting from the very first one, tentatively planned for September 2016. For editorial reasons, we would like to have the broad range of ecohydraulic topics represented in each journal issue. Special issues on specific topics may be considered later.

In order to start this process, we kindly ask you to let us know by **Jan 26th** if you might be interested in developing the work described in your extended abstract/full paper into a manuscript for submission to the Journal of Ecohydraulics. Preference will be given to those ISE2016 papers/extended abstracts which received strongly positive reviews. We would appreciate a manuscript title with your response to help us ensure broad coverage of ecohydraulics topics.

Please note that we are working on a mechanism to submit papers to the Journal of Ecohydraulics, as well as manuscript templates, submission deadlines, etc. This is work in progress and the feedback we receive from you in response to this email is important to the journal development and will assist us in providing further details during the Symposium.
