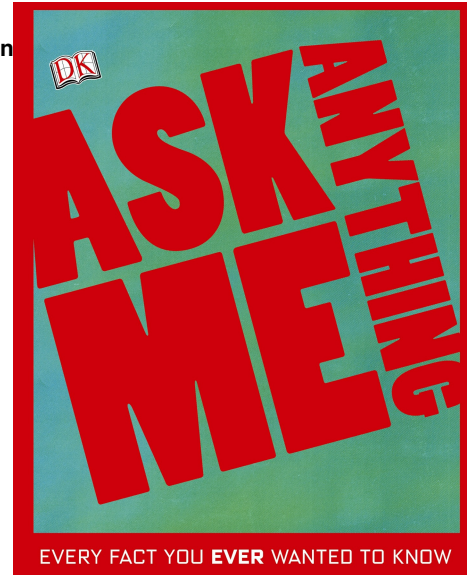

The **page layouts** are busy but **easy-to-read** although you do have to **rotate** the book sometimes to **read** the copy.

It's a great book to dip into for **fascinating facts** like the flatulence of a single sheep could **power** a small truck for 25 miles a day! Or that a **man** will shave 20,000 times in an **average lifetime?** And you can solve the **problem** of where you go to **post letters** under water – should the need arise!
