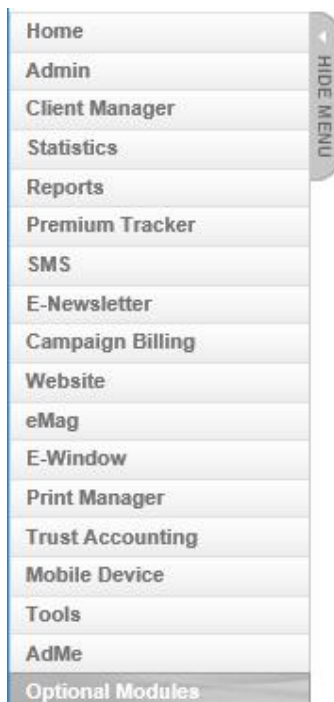


Enabling Google Translate

2. Select **show menu** to produce the main menu of the website



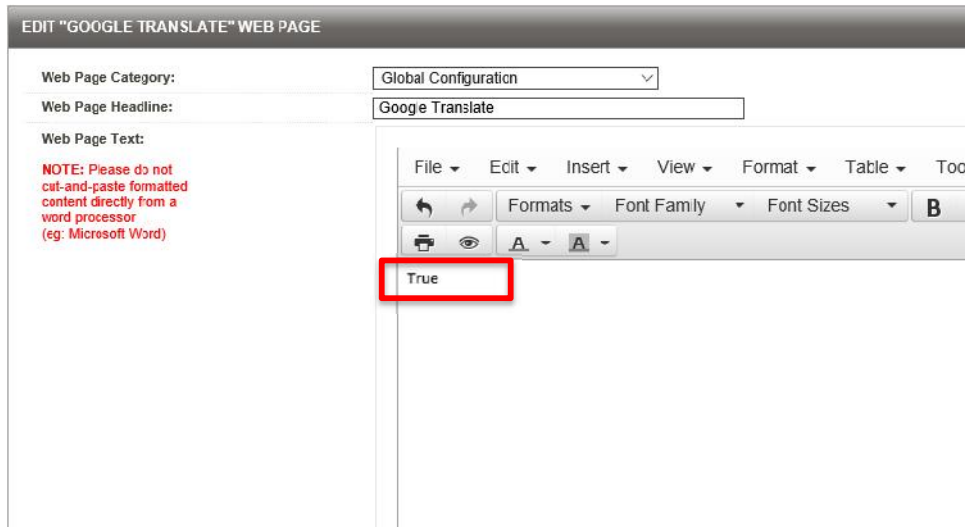
3. Select Website and the subheading Webpage list
