Finneytown's average ACT composite score for the past three years was 21.3.

CLASS RANK

In determining class rank, Honors and AP courses receive add-on weight to the GPA for grades above a "C". Honors courses receive an add-on weight of 0.050 for full year courses and 0.025 for semester courses. AP courses receive add-on weight of 0.100 for full year courses and 0.50 for semester courses.
