

Travel Guide to Tarab

ARRIVAL

The simplest way to travel to the festival grounds is through the Shuttle bus from Vienna, this will take you directly to our wonderful valley. If you want to travel by car you can carpool. We have created a Facebook group in which you can exchange travel information.

The Navigational Address is: Zsámbéki Színházi Bázis, Zsámbék, 2072 Hungary.

You will have to leave your cars at a parking space close to the grounds since automobiles are not permitted on location. The only exception to this are a limited amount of campervans for guests that have purchased the campervan ticket. The fee for parking with car will be 8 € or 2000 forint for the whole festival. This fee is 100% for the owner of the field and has nothing to do with us.

If possible please avoid travelling by plane, instead use trains and buses. From Budapest you can either take the Busline 795 (Entry: Budapest, Station "Széll Kálmán tér", Exit: Zsámbék "Szent István tér") or with the Busline 784 (Entry: Budapest "Széll Kálmán tér", Exit: „Szomori Elágazás”) to Zsambek. The busses drive every 20 minutes.

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE TIMES

The festival grounds can be accessed from Thursday, 11.07.2019 at 12:00. The festival ends on Sunday, 14.07.2019 at 18:00, the grounds will close for all visitors at 20:00.

The shuttle buses will be driving on Thursday at 12:00 and 16:00 as well as on Friday at 12:00, 15:00, and 18:00 from Vienna (U2 Stadion) directly to the Festival.

The shuttle buses will be driving back to Vienna from the festival grounds on Sunday at 16:00 and 20:00.

ACCESSIBILITY

The festival grounds are not barrier-free. If you have a disability and would like to attend our festival, please write us an [email](#) so that together we can figure out a way how best to support your needs.

ATM

There is no cash machine on the festival grounds. The next ATM is in the COOP Market Zsámbék, Akadémia u. 1, 2072 Hungary. You will be able to purchase our festival currency by card and therefore will not be needing much hardcash.

AWARENESS/PSYCARE

There will be an awareness team on site that will provide support for people affected by any form of abuse. Please take care of each other and fetch the necessary help in case you witness assault, use of force, sexism, racism, or any other forms of discrimination. Practice reflected and respectful forms of interaction with your company and nature.

Additionally we will have a team on location that will tend to you if anything becomes too much for you to handle and/or need mental support. You will find both booths, Awareness and Psycare, operating twenty-four-seven.

We retain the right to dismiss any visitors from the grounds, with accord of the victim, that act (sexist, racist, discriminating) inappropriately.

BRACELETS

During the entry of the grounds, your ticket will be swapped for a festival bracelet. This is not transferable. We will be keeping an eye out for people without bracelets on the grounds. Anyone caught on the festival area without a bracelet will be kicked out of the experience of Tarab.

COLLECTIVE CELEBRATION

Our aim is that everyone visiting our festival feels comfortable. This is why we want everyone to take care of each other so that no one is left alone in an uncomfortable situation. If you notice anything odd, please inform someone at the bars or booths, these have numbers of supporters.

Of course the awareness stand is there for you twenty-four-seven if any of your boundaries have been stepped on. We ask you to be aware of your fellow dancers and to assist them if needed! Respect each other!

CURRENCY

In the Valley of Tarab there will be an own Tarab Thaler – you can trade earthly currencies such as Euro or Forint at our Currency Exchange booth. This booth will be running from 12-24 o'clock, therefore its best to exchange enough for the night, in case of emergency there will always be alternative option of exchanging money at the Infopoint. Due to tax purposes we will not be able to exchange our festival currency back to Earthly currencies.

DOGS

A festival is not a suitable location for dogs. Except for the dogs belonging to our crew, no dogs are allowed on the festival grounds!

DRINKING WATER

It is not clear yet whether we will have running drinking water on the old military property on which our festival is taking place. As soon as we know more, we will let you know. It is of course one of our highest priorities to provide our visitors with enough possibilities to access drinking water, this is why we have invited the Waterbar from Austria that will provide refreshment with their brand new watermobile. You'll definitely put a smile on their faces with a little donation.

In case there is no running drinking water on the territory, we will be setting up large water tanks. No need to worry, there will be water in either scenario. In addition there will be mineral water for a cost price at all bars. Please do not forget to drink water, it's summer and dancing makes you thirsty!

There will be showers, so no worries about washing possibilities.

FIRE

There is a strict fire prohibition on the entire festival area due to forest fire risks. Please also be careful while smoking cigarettes and use the provided pocket-ashtray without exception. In case of emergency all floors and bars are equipped with fire extinguishers.

GLASS

We want everyone to feel free and safe on the festival grounds. When you're dancing barefoot you surely don't want to be stepping into glass shards. Therefore we ask you to bring as little glass as possible. Refill your glass bottles into other materials when you are going to the floors and if you see glass on the floor please feel responsible to either let us know or take it away yourselves.

GRILLS AND CAMP COOKERS

The use of grills and camping cookers is not allowed on the festival grounds due to fire safety regulations.

KIOSK

If you have forgotten your toothbrush or just need a few healthy snacks to replenish your energy, you will not have to drive into town! Simply go on a journey to space: our kiosk is a rocket that will quickly shoot you back into ease.

LIABILITY

Participation of the festival generally occurs on personal responsibility. We do not take accountability for bodily and object harm during the event or the arrival and departure of the grounds.

MUSIC BREAKS

There will be no real celebration breaks during the timespan of the festival WOOHOO! Yet we will have to appeal a short music break on some floors to restore them to prime rave conditions. You're welcome to help us with this by actually using the trash cans provided.

OWN SOUNDSYSTEMS

Please refrain from bringing your own soundsystem! The camping grounds are a place of retreat, we assure you that the festival stereo will guide you to ecstasy. Even small stereos should not be running!

CONFETTI & GLITTER

Please only use biodegradable confetti and glitter. If you don't have any with you, then you can purchase these at our kiosk.

FIRST AID

We have a well equipped medical tent and trained personnel. Do not hesitate to approach them, if you or someone else needs attention!

FOOD: VEGETARIAN

Protecting the environment and respecting all souls lies close to our hearts. Therefore the entire food offer from our food trucks will be Vegetarian!

LOCATION

Please take as little packaging material with you as possible to the festival. We take the separation of waste on our grounds very seriously. Hence you will be provided with 2 garbage bags while entering, one for glass, cans, and plastic, the other for your residual waste.
