# Man, Cancer and Immunity

Evidence has been accumulating during the last decade to suggest that some cancer patients react against their tumours, and that the immune system is involved in this reaction. In this book, studies *in vivo* and *in vitro*, which demonstrate such interactions, are critically discussed. These include assessments of membrane characteristics of tumour cells, the different classes of tumour-associated antigens, the immunological reactions to such antigens and the mechanisms whereby tumour cells may survive and proliferate in the presence of established anti-tumour immunity. Also considered are the more clinical aspects, detection and quantification of immune responses to tumour cells and the effects of conventional forms of treatment of cancer on such responses. The utility of immunological assessment in cancer diagnosis, prognosis, treatment planning and monitoring the clinically tumour free individual is discussed. Whereas much of the previously published work on this subject has devoted attention to studies in animals, in this volume the author concentrates on studies in Man.
