



If you are flying to NYC, we recommend that you book a flight that lands no later than 1pm on Saturday, May 16. This will still give you sufficient time to get your luggage and travel from the airport and get to the expo before it closes. If you booked your flight already, call the airline to change your ticket.

IMPORTANT!

GFNY race packet pickup hours are: May 15 & 16 at 10am-6:30pm.

In-person race packet pickup is mandatory. Each participant must come in person to check-in and pick up their race materials.

You must come to GFNY Registration on Friday or Saturday ONLY. You must be at the expo before 6:30pm on Saturday, May 16 in order to be able to pick up your race packet.

If you do not come to the expo during expo hours, you forfeit your registration and ability to take part in the event.

Q: Which hotel is the best choice for me?

If you are traveling to NYC to experience Manhattan and everything New York City has to offer, we strongly recommend staying in a Manhattan hotel.

If you have been to NYC often and are in town only for the race, not for tourism, and want a hotel near the start and finish, we recommend staying in Fort Lee.

Q: NYC has a lot of hotel options. Why should I book an official GFNY hotel?

- 1. Location: we know what makes sense from a GFNY perspective.
- 2. They allow bikes in your hotel room, which is rare in NYC.
- 3. You are around other participants for an impromptu training ride or sharing war stories after the event.
- 4. Guaranteed availability of a 4am breakfast on raceday to fuel you for the big day.
- 5. We've done the research; all you need to do is book.
- 6. The hotels offer discounted rates to you and not a commission to us.


May is a busy month in NYC. Make sure you book your stay now.

Bike Transport


By bringing your bike to the race, you are sure to ride a bike in the right size, with the components that you prefer and in the condition that you as the owner maintain your beloved bike.

Elite is the official travel case sponsor of the GFNY World Championship. The <u>Elite Vaison</u> hard case is durable and easy to pack and keeps your bike safe. Click here for an instructional video: https://youtu.be/sQIfHd39mgs

The newest bike case offering from Elite is the <u>Elite Borson</u> soft bag. It took years to develop and perfect, and makes bike packing a breeze. Click here for an instructional video: youtu.be/L6tE7Uwg2b4

The lowest budget (free) option for a bike carton is visiting your local bike shop and picking up a carton box from a bike sale they've just made. Most bike shops just throw out the cardboard cartons and are happy for you to reduce their trash.

American Airlines and Delta now do not charge oversize fees for bikes, making it more affordable than ever to fly with your bike.

Bike Shipping

Luggage Free is providing you the option to send your bike ahead to your hotel, to Unlimited Biking, or to one of GFNY's partner bike shops. Be sure to confirm and book the assembly and packing service with Unlimited Biking or the bike shop prior to shipping your bike - many bike shops are very busy during GFNY race week. You can also ship your luggage ahead. Book your luggage and bike shipping here: luggagefree.com/partners/gfny

Parking, you will see Unlimited Biking flags, tent and staff waiting to collect your rental bike.

Note that we do not recommend shipping your bike internationally. When shipping the bike internationally, you run the risk of the bike getting stuck in customs and potentially not arriving to the race in time. Instead, we recommend flying with your bike.

Bike Concierge

Unlimited Biking also offers Bike Concierge service. UB's expert team will assemble and tune up your bike, so all you have to do is show up and race.

- 1. SHIP IT: Pack your bike and ship it to Unlimited Biking.
- 2. UB ASSEMBLES: Unlimited Biking's professional team of mechanics will assemble and tune your bike.
- **3. PICK UP IN FORT LEE:** UB will deliver all bikes to Fort Lee. Your bike ready for pickup at the GFNY packet pickup area in Fort Lee. You will be able to make any pre-race adjustments with the UB team onsite at the expo.
- **4. UB PACKS AND SHIPS BACK:** Leave the bike with Unlimited Biking after the race. UB's team will be at the GFNY Finish Village to collect your bike, disassemble it, pack it, and ship it back to you.

Bike Tune-up:

Tune up your bike with Unlimited Biking. Depending on your bike needs, you can select from the basic tune up to the complete overhaul tune up. Book your bike tune up in advance, then bring your bike to the packet pickup area where you will meet UB's expert mechanics.

Recommended activities

- Ride portions of the GFNY course. The GFNY Welcome Zone in Fort Lee is a great meeting point for before & after your ride. Location: PIP Park, Fort Lee, NJ. Join GFNY's Race Week Group Rides.
- Ride a few loops in Central Park. Check out the <u>6-mile / 10km route</u> through Central Park's 778 acres (315 ha) dedicated to nature and recreation. Central Park is one of NYC's most famous tourism attractions.
- Buildings with high-floor observation decks like Empire State Building, Top of the Rock, One World Observatory
- River cruises, ferry taxis or the Staten Island Ferry for sightseeing the Statue of Liberty and the city from water
- Walk or ride through various neighborhoods of NYC, all of which have a history and their unique characteristics. For example: West Village, Greenwich Village, TriBeCa, SoHo, East Village, LES, NoHo, Bowery, Gramercy, Meat Packing, FiDi, Times Square, Upper West Side, Upper East Side and more.

GFNY week kicks off with a four-day pre-race GFNY Welcome Zone experience at PIP Park in Fort Lee, NJ.


The GFNY Welcome Zone offers riders another way to connect with GFNY, other GFNY riders and their families and friends.

Airport Transfers

If you land at JFK, the budget option is taking the A train. Not all the stations are handicap accessible, which means there aren't elevators to go up/down stairs with your luggage & bike box. If you want to take the subway, check the subway map to make sure there is handicap accessibility at the stations you'll travel through: 1. the stations where you may need to make a connection and 2. the stop closest to you where you're staying. http://web.mta.info/maps/submap.html

Within NYC and its airports, JFK and LGA, the easiest transport option is hailing a yellow taxi. However, May is a high-tourism month in NYC and you may end up having to wait a long time in line to get a taxi. We recommend using either Uber or Lyft apps or scheduling a car service pickup in advance.



Q: DO I HAVE TO QUALIFY TO TAKE PART IN THE GFNY WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP?

A: No. The qualification is for riders who want to start in the Qualifier Corral, seeded in the front of the field.

If you finished in the top 10% of your age group in the long route at any GFNY World race or in the top 20% at a Championship GFNY (Regional or World Championship), you earn a Qualifier Corral starting position for the following 380 days. To check your qualification status, log into your GFNY account at gfny.cc.

Q: DO I NEED TO BE A LICENSED RACER? I JUST WANT TO RIDE AS A PERSONAL CHALLENGE.

A: GFNY is open to all fitness levels. You don't need to be a licensed racer. Some riders will compete for prizes, others aim to beat the cut-off. GFNY is about doing your best whether it is competing for the win, aiming to earn Qualifier status or beating the time cut-off.

Q: I REGISTERED FOR GFNY 100, BUT I PREFER TO RIDE GFNY BEAR 50. IS THAT POSSIBLE?
Q: I REGISTERED FOR GFNY BEAR 50, BUT I PREFER TO RIDE GFNY 100. IS THAT POSSIBLE?
A: You can transfer your GFNY 100 registration to a GFNY BEAR 50 or your GFNY BEAR 50 registration to GFNY 100 registration at no extra cost until 21 days before race day. To make your distance change, log into your gfny.cc account and click on the "edit" button aside your ticket to make any changes.

Q: I'M TRAVELING FROM ABROAD AND DON'T HAVE US HEALTH INSURANCE. I'M CONCERNED ABOUT IF SOMETHING HAPPENDS TO ME DURING MY TRIP AND HOW TO PAY FOR IT.

A: We strongly encourage any rider without a USA-based health insurance to purchase travel insurance and a one-day license from USA Cycling to assist with any potential expenses incurred during your trip or during the event.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: Contact the travel agent or website where you booked your flight or contact your credit card company that you booked your trip with. Travel insurance can cost under \$100 but provides you an insurance policy for your trip, and a variety of services should you need them. Check the terms of the insurance policy to know exactly what is covered.

ONE-DAY LICENSE: GFNY is a sanctioned event under USA Cycling, the national cycling federation. USA Cycling offers one-day and 12-month medical insurance options. Purchasing this extra insurance is optional, but highly encouraged, particularly for riders without US-based health insurance. Visit the USA Cycling booth at the GFNY pre-race expo to purchase your 1-day license.

Q: I NEED TO CHANGE MY JERSEY SIZE / TEAM AFFILIATION / CATEGORY. HOW CAN I DO THAT?

A: Log into your gfny.cc account and click on the "edit" button aside your ticket to make any changes.

Q: WHAT IS INCLUDED WITH THE ENTRY FEE?

A: GFNY full zip cycling jersey Designed in New York City and Made in Italy by GFNY, GFNY bike bottle by Elite, GFNY race poster, GFNY race magazine, various GFNY goodies, course marking, aid stations, chip timing, post race meal, competition and raffle prizes, bike valet service at the expo and at GFNY Finish Village and much, much more.

GFNY BEAR 50 riders receive return transport by bus (your bike travels in an accompanying truck) to GFNY Finish Village.
