The SPS employs a Boundary Plan for the assignment of students in grades kindergarten through grade 8. This plan is designed to associate every address with a corresponding Boundary School. This tool will be useful in identifying your student's Boundary School.

Frequently Asked Questions:

What do I do if my street or building/house number is not listed?

Buildings that have multiple units or apartments are listed by building number only. You may contact the Parent Information Center if you do not find your street or building number on the list.

My street is listed twice. Which one do I select?

There are six (6) streets in Springfield that have similar names. The duplicate street names are found in the Indian Orchard section of the city. They are identified with IO next to the street name.

- Cedar St and Cedar Street IO
- Chestnut St and Chestnut Street IO
- Hampden St and Hampden Street IO
- Main St and Main Street IO
- Myrtle St and Myrtle Street IO
- Oak St and Oak Street IO

I have moved to a new address. Should I take my children to the new boundary school?
