AGREEMENT by and between, the American Society for Microbiology (ASM), a not-forprofit, tax-exempt association with its principal office at 1752 N Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20036 ("Licensor"), and [name] _______,

("Licensee") (the two entities collectively referred to as "the Parties"), has been executed as of the Effective Date set forth on the Cover Sheet attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein and for good and valuable consideration, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Definitions

- **1.1 ASM Press eBooks Collections**. Compilations of ASM-Press-published books grouped by individual copyright year and provided electronically by ASM. (See Schedule A for a list of the collections and titles included in this Agreement.)
- 1.2 Authorized Users. Any individual who, if Licensee and its Member Sites are academic institutions, is a registered student, faculty member, staff member, or affiliated researcher, or, if Licensee and its Member Sites are companies or government entities, is an employee or independent contractor, permitted access to Licensee's Secure Network. An affiliated researcher or independent contractor must be employed, and/or conducting research, physically at Licensee's site or a Member Site's location. A visitor to Licensee's site and/or its Member Sites who is authorized to use that facility's library network is considered to be an Authorized User. Authorized Users may be remote users so long as they are affiliated with Licensee or its Member Sites) may be considered Authorized Users only if they are physically present at the Licensee's site.
- **1.3 Commercial Use**. Use of Licensed Materials for the purpose of monetary reward (whether by or for the Licensee, Member Site or an Authorized User) through the sale, resale, loan, transfer, hire or other form of exploitation of the Licensed Materials. Neither recovery of direct costs by the Licensee and/or Member Sites from Authorized Users, nor use by the Licensee and/or Member Sites from Authorized Users of the Licensed Materials in the course of funded research, including research funded by a commercial organization, shall be deemed Commercial Use.
- 1.4 **Consortium**. A Consortium is a group of academic educational institutions or companies with multiple sites and their libraries that have authorized a single administrative organization to negotiate this Agreement on their behalf. A Consortium may consist of units of a single legal entity (for example, different branches of a state university), or institutions that are separate legal entities. A Consortium is categorized as different tiers based on the following number of faculty plus individuals in registered doctoral (PhD, MD, DVM, etc.)

and postdoctoral programs in the life sciences (if Licensee is an academic institution) or number of employees (if Licensee is a company):

1 - 200 (Tier A) 201 - 1,500 (Tier B) 1,501 - 3,500 (Tier C)

1.5 Licensed Materials. The ASM Press eBook Collection(s) selected on the Cover Sheet.

- **1.6 Member Sites**. Individual entities listed in Schedule B of this License Agreement which are members of the Consortium (Licensee) which is a Party to this Agreement. Individual Member Sites may purchase access to products under this Agreement. Each Member Site is regarded as a single organization for the purposes of this Agreement even though it may be spread over a number of locations. Individual Member Sites may be added to or withdrawn from inclusion in this Agreement by mutual agreement of Licensor and Licensee.
- **1.7 Purchase Fee.** A one-time payment for nonexclusive perpetual access to the Licensed Materials, subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- **1.8 Secure Network.** A network (whether a standalone network or a virtual network on the Internet), which is accessible only to Authorized Users approved by the Licensee and/or its Member Sites, requiring the identity of a user to be authenticated at the time of log-in and periodically thereafter consistent with current best practice, and whose conduct is subject to regulation by the Licensee and/or its Member Sites. A proxy server may be included in the network.

2. License Grant

- **2.1 Use**. Subject to all terms and conditions of this Agreement, Licensor hereby grants to Licensee and its Member Sites upon the purchase of the Licensed Materials a limited, nonassignable, nonexclusive Multi Site / Consortium license to access and use the Licensed Materials and the right to sublicense access to and use of the Licensed Materials to Authorized Users, but not for any Commercial Use. Use and access under this license grant shall include the following:
 - A. <u>Print; Download; Extraction</u>. Consistent with the Fair Use provisions of Section 107 of the U.S. Copyright Act, Licensee, its Member Sites and Authorized Users may display, print, download, extract, share with Authorized Users, or use individual chapters of content contained in the Licensed Materials for educational, scientific, or research purposes, including extraction and manipulation of information for the purpose of illustration, explanation, example, comment, criticism, teaching, research, or analysis.
 - B. <u>Electronic Links</u>. Licensees and its Member Sites may provide secure electronic links to the Licensed Materials from Licensee's and Member Sites' web page(s)

to increase the usefulness of the Licensed Materials to Authorized Users. Upon request, Licensor will assist Licensee and its Member Sites in creating such links and Licensee shall make changes to the appearance of such links and/or in statements accompanying such links as requested by Licensor.

- C. For library e-reserve or course syllabus purposes, Licensee and its Member Sites may provide metadata with appropriate links to one or more individual chapters or articles for Authorized Users to access the full-text format.
- D. <u>Interlibrary Loan</u>: Licensee and its Member Sites may download and print individual articles that are faxed, mailed, hand-delivered, or scanned and transmitted electronically to a requester under Licensee's interlibrary loan procedures, so long as the requesting institution is a non-commercial library located in the same country as Licensee. No other form of electronic transmission or forwarding of Licensed Materials is permitted.
- E. <u>Text and Data Mining</u>. Authorized Users are permitted to engage in Text and Data Mining (TDM) meaning: downloading, extracting and indexing information from the Licensed Materials. Where required, TDM includes mounting, loading and integrating the results on a server used for the Licensee's and/or its Member Sites' text-mining system and evaluate and interpret the TDM output for access and use by Authorized Users. The Licensee and its Member Sites shall ensure compliance with Licensee's obligations set forth in Section 4.2 of this Agreement, including but not limited to security and technical access requirements. TDM may be undertaken on either locally loaded Licensed Materials or as mutually agreed.
- F. <u>CLOCKSS System</u>. Licensee and its Member Sites are authorized to utilize the <u>CLOCKSS System</u> of archiving in order to preserve the Licensee's use of and access to Licensed Materials in the event that Licensor no longer provides such access as defined by the CLOCKSS triggering event parameters. This permission is granted on the further condition that Licensee and its Member Sites install and maintain, at their own expense, any software or other mechanism and authorizations needed to participate in the CLOCKSS system.

2.2 Access

Authorized Users' access to the Licensed Materials is controlled by valid Internet Protocol ("IP") address(es), or range(s) of IP addresses, which Licensee is responsible for providing. Only the IP address(es) submitted by the Licensee at the time of purchase may have access to the Licensed Materials. Addition of IP addresses at any other time must be approved in advance by Licensor and may require additional payment if the addition(s) increases the number of Authorized Users. Licensee and its Member Sites may use a proxy server for providing remote dial-in access for its Authorized Users, but the use of an open proxy server is prohibited.

3. Ownership of Intellectual Property

3.1 All right, title and interest in the Licensed Materials and all intellectual property rights related thereto, including but not limited to content, data, trademarks, copyrights, and any derivative works derived therefrom, shall be and remain with Licensor. Neither Licensee, its

Member Sites, nor Authorized Users shall have any right, title or interest in the Licensed Materials nor in any related intellectual property rights except as expressly set forth herein.

3.2 Removal of Copyright Notice. Neither Licensee, its Member Sites, nor Authorized Users shall remove, obscure or modify any copyright or other notices in the Licensed Materials.

3.3 Modification. Other than as set forth herein, neither Licensee, its Member Sites, nor Authorized Users shall modify or create a derivative work of the Licensed Materials, in whole or in part, without prior express written permission of Licensor.

4. Obligations and Representations and Warranties

4.1 Licensor

- A. Licensor represents and warrants that to the best of Licensor's knowledge, the Licensed Materials used as contemplated by this Agreement do not infringe the copyright or any other proprietary or intellectual property rights of any third party. Licensor shall indemnify and hold Licensee and its Member Sites harmless from and against any loss, damage, costs, liability and expenses (including reasonable legal and professional fees) arising out of legal action taken against Licensee due to an actual or alleged infringement of such rights. This indemnity shall not apply if Licensee, its Member Sites and/or Authorized Users have modified or used the Licensed Materials in any way not permitted by this Agreement.
- B. Licensor reserves the right to withdraw from the Licensed Materials any material which it no longer retains the right to publish, or which it has reasonable grounds to believe infringes copyright or is defamatory, obscene, unlawful, or otherwise objectionable. Licensor shall give written notice of the withdrawal to Licensee within sixty (60) days of the removal of any material pursuant to this Section 4.
- C. Licensor shall comply with the American with Disabilities Act (ADA) by supporting assistive software or devices such as large print interfaces, voice-activated input, and alternate keyboard or pointer interfaces in a manner consistent with generally accepted best practices.
- D. Licensor shall make statistics regarding the usage of the Licensed Materials by Licensee and/or its Member Sites and their Authorized Users available to Licensee and/or its Member Sites consistent with generally accepted best practices. Licensor will provide ongoing access to usage statistics on a password-protected site.
- E. Licensor shall use reasonable efforts to provide continuous access to the Licensed Materials. Unavailability may occur related to failure of equipment or services beyond the control of Licensor. Every effort will be made to minimize any downtime and to restore services in the event of a failure beyond the control of Licensor.

4.2 Licensee

- A. Licensee agrees to the terms and conditions herein on behalf of all Member Sites and shall be responsible for compliance with same on behalf of Authorized Users. Licensee represents and warrants that it has the right and authority to enter into this Agreement and act on behalf of the Member Sites and Authorized Users.
- B. Licensee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Licensor, its officers, directors,

- C. Licensee agrees to designate a single person to be the administrator of this Agreement. The name, address, phone number, and e-mail address of the Agreement administrator shall be listed on the Cover Sheet and Schedule B. Licensee shall notify Licensor of any changes to the assigned administrator or contact information.
- D. Licensee represents and warrants that it will use best efforts to notify its Member Sites and Authorized Users of the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- E. Licensee represents and warrants that it will provide access to the Licensed Materials on a Secure Network. Licensee, Member Sites, and their Authorized Users shall be granted access pursuant to IP addresses, passwords, public keys or certificates, or other security protocols developed and accepted during the term of this Agreement. Licensee shall provide via separate electronic delivery to Licensor a complete set of valid IP addresses for each Member Site included in Schedule B to enable Licensor to authenticate users and to supply accurate statistics. The form of these IP addresses must be acceptable to Licensor. Only those IP addresses submitted by the Licensee will have access to the Licensed Materials, and Licensee is responsible for promptly notifying Licensor of any changes in the IP addresses. Licensee is responsible for deleting any expired or inaccurate IP address(es) from the subscription account and for taking reasonable measures to prevent access by unauthorized individuals to its authorized IP address(es).
- F. <u>Detection of Prohibited Uses</u>. Licensee and its Member Sites are responsible for taking reasonable measures to prevent prohibited uses and to promptly notify Licensor of any infringements of copyright or prohibited use of which Licensee and/or its Member Sites become aware. - 5.4 IN NO EVENT SHALL LICENSOR BE LIABLE FOR MORE THAN THE FEES PAID BY LICENSEE AND/OR ITS MEMBER SITES UNDER THIS AGREEMENT. 6. Payment

6.1 The fees due under this Agreement are set forth on the Cover Sheet. Licensor shall invoice Licensee for the Purchase Fee with payment due within thirty (30) days receipt of invoice.

7. Term and Termination

7.1 <u>Term</u>. The term of this Agreement shall be perpetual.

7.2 <u>Termination</u>. Licensor may terminate if Licensee does not pay the fee(s) set forth on the Cover Sheet and described in Section 6 or if Licensee or any Member Site breaches the obligations set forth in Sections 4.2, 4.3 or 8. Termination shall be effective upon thirty (30) days notice to Licensee. In the event of termination, no refund or partial refund of fees will be given.

7.3 <u>Effect of Termination</u>. Upon termination, Licensee shall be entitled to keep a permanent flat file (.PDF) copy of the Licensed Materials. Also upon termination, any links to Licensed Materials under Sections 2.1(B) and (C) shall be removed.

8. Confidential Information

8.1 Each Party acknowledges that, in connection with the performance of this Agreement, it may receive certain confidential or proprietary technical, business or financial information and materials of the other Party or data related to the usage of the Licensed Materials by Licensee, its Member Sites and Authorized Users ("Confidential Information"). Confidential Information shall include the disclosing Party's service offerings, methodologies, software, product documentation, data, legal strategies and work product, and any other business, financial or technical information that is marked or otherwise identified as confidential or proprietary.

8.2 Both Parties agree (a) to use the other Party's Confidential Information only for the purposes described in this Agreement; (b) not to reproduce the other Party's Confidential Information and will hold in confidence and protect such Confidential Information from dissemination to, and use by, any third party; and (c) to restrict access to the other Party's Confidential Information to such of its personnel, agents, suppliers and/or consultants, if any, who have a need to have access and who have been advised of and have agreed in writing to treat such information in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. Both Parties agree that all Confidential Information is proprietary to the disclosing Party or such third party, as applicable, and shall remain the sole property of the disclosing Party or such third party.

8.3 Notwithstanding the foregoing, each Party may disclose Confidential Information (a) if expressly authorized in writing by the subject of that information; (b) in response to an order of a court or other governmental body; (c) as required by law or regulation to be disclosed; or (d) in order to establish a Party's rights under this Agreement.

8.4 If either Party breaches this Section 8, the non-breaching Party will suffer irreparable harm, the total monetary damages for which will be impossible to calculate and therefore inadequate. Accordingly, the non-breaching Party may a) seek appropriate injunctive relief against the breaching Party or b) exercise any other rights and seek any other remedies to which the non-breaching Party may be entitled at law, in equity and under this Agreement.

9. General

- **9.1** <u>Entire Agreement</u>. - **9.6** <u>Good Faith Resolution</u>. If there are any disputes or disagreements regarding the terms and conditions of this Agreement, both Parties agree to work in good faith to resolve the issues.
- **9.7** <u>Governing Law; Venue</u>. This Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the District of Columbia, without regard to its principles regarding conflicts of law. Each Party hereby irrevocably submits to, and waives any objection to, the exclusive personal jurisdiction of the state and federal courts located in the District of Columbia.
- **<u>9.8</u>** Survival. The provisions of Sections 3, 4.2, 4.3, 5, 7.3, 8 and 9 shall survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement.
- **9.9** <u>Non-discrimination</u>. The parties agree to comply with all applicable laws, rules, regulations, and executive orders governing equal employment opportunity, immigration, non-discrimination, including the Americans with Disabilities Act, and affirmative action. The vendor for the ASM Journals Online complies with the W3C Priority 1 international standards for accessibility and has represented to ASM that compliance with Section 508 of the Americans with Disabilities Act was completed in late 2007.
- **9.10** Government Requirements. ASM complies with all provisions of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) clauses applicable to the goods and services licensed pursuant to this Agreement.
