¹<u>Types of fees</u> - Separate charges as shown in the schedule will be assessed for preapplication consultations and reviews; applications for new licenses, approvals, or license terminations; possession only licenses; issuance of new licenses and approvals; certain amendments and certain renewals to existing licenses and approvals; safety evaluations of sealed sources and devices; and certain inspections. The following guidelines apply to these charges:

(a) <u>Application fees</u> - Applications for new materials licenses; applications to reinstate

expired, terminated or inactive licenses except those subject to fees assessed at full cost; must be accompanied by the prescribed application fee for each category:

(1) Applications for licenses covering more than one fee category of special nuclear material or source material must be accompanied by the prescribed application fee for the highest fee category.

(2) An application for amendment to a materials license or approval that would place the license or approval in a higher fee category or add a new fee category must be accompanied by the prescribed application fee for the new category.

(3) Applications for new licenses that cover both byproduct material and special nuclear material in sealed sources for use in gauging devices will pay the appropriate application fee for fee Category 1.A. only.

(b) <u>Licensing fees</u> - Fees for reviews of applications for new licenses and for renewals and amendments to existing licenses, for pre-application consultations and for review of other documents submitted to the Agency for review, and for project manager time for fee categories subject to full cost fees, are due upon notification by the Agency.

(c) <u>Amendment fees</u> - An application for an amendment to a license or approval classified in more than one fee category must be accompanied by the prescribed amendment fee for the category affected by the amendment unless the amendment is applicable to two or more fee categories, in which case the amendment fee for the highest fee category would apply.

(d) <u>Inspection fees</u> - Inspections resulting from investigations conducted by the Agency, and non-routine inspections that result from third party allegations, are not subject to fees. The fees assessed at full cost will be determined based on the professional staff time required to conduct the inspection multiplied by the rate of \$197.25 per hour to which any applicable contractual support services costs incurred will be added. Inspection fees are due upon notification by the Agency in accordance with Section 22-32-5, Code of Alabama.

Fees will not be assessed for requests/reports submitted to the Agency:

(1) In response to a Generic Letter or Agency/NRC Bulletin that does not result in an amendment to the license, does not result in the review of an alternate method or reanalysis to meet the requirements of the Generic Letter, or does not involve an unreviewed safety issue;

(2) In response to an Agency request to resolve an identified safety, safeguards or environmental issue, or to assist the Agency in developing a rule, regulatory guide, policy statement, generic letter, or bulletin; or

(3) As a means of exchanging information between industry organizations and the Agency for the purpose of supporting generic regulatory improvements or efforts.

(f) <u>Annual fees</u> - Materials Licensees, Holders of Certificates of Compliance, Holders

of Sealed Source and Device Registrations, and Holders of Quality Assurance Program Approvals.

(1) Person(s) who conduct activities authorized by a license issued pursuant to 420-3-26-.02 shall pay an annual fee for each license, certificate, approval or registration the person(s) holds on October 1 of the fiscal year for which the annual fee is due. If a person holds more than one license, certificate, registration, or approval, the annual fee will be the cumulative total of the annual fees applicable to the licenses, certificates, registrations or approvals held by that person. For those licenses that authorize more than one activity on a single license (e.g., human use and irradiator activities), annual fees will be assessed for each category applicable to the license.

(2) When a new license is issued, or if an existing license is amended to authorize more than one activity, during the first half of the fiscal year (October 1 through March 31), the licensee will be invoiced for one half of the annual fee for that fiscal year. Such invoicing will occur within one month of the license issuance or amendment. When a new license is issued, or if an existing license is amended to authorize more than one activity, during the second half of a fiscal year (April 1 through September 30), the licensee will not be assessed an annual fee for that fiscal year. Thereafter, the full fee is due and payable at the beginning of each subsequent fiscal year.

(3) Payment of the prescribed annual fee does not automatically renew the license or approval for which the fee is paid. Renewal applications must be filed in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 420-3-26, Radiation Control, Alabama Administrative Code.

(4) The Agency is entitled to collect any underpayment of fees as a result of an error by the Agency.

(5) Licenses meeting certain requirements may apply for a reduction in annual fees provided criteria described in the *Certification of Small Entity Status* form are met. The form can be found at <u>http://www.alabamapublichealth.gov/radiation/assets/SmallEntityForm.pdf</u>.

²Fees will not be charged for orders issued by the Agency pursuant to 420-3-26-.13 nor for amendments resulting specifically from such Agency orders. However, fees will be charged for approvals issued pursuant to a specific exemption provision of the Agency=s regulations similar to those issued under Title 10 of Code of Federal Regulations (e.g., 10CFR30.11, 40.14, 70.14, 73.5, and any other sections now or hereafter in effect) regardless of whether the approval is in the form of a license amendment, letter of approval, safety evaluation report, or other form. For orders unrelated to civil penalties or other civil sanctions, fees will be charged for any resulting licensee-specific activities not otherwise exempted from fees under this chapter.

³Full cost fees will be determined based on the professional staff time multiplied by the professional hourly rate and appropriate contractual support services expended. Any professional hours expended on or after August 24, 2018 will be assessed at the rate of \$208.50 per hour.

⁴[Reserved]

⁵A Class I license includes mill licenses issued for the extraction of uranium from uranium

ore. A Class II license includes solution mining licenses (in-situ and heap leach) issued for the extraction of uranium from uranium ores including research and development licenses. An Aother@ license includes licenses for extraction of metals, heavy metals, and rare earths.

⁶Licensees paying fees under 3.N. are not subject to paying fees under 3.P. for calibration or leak testing services authorized on the same license.

⁷Persons who possess radium sources that are used for operational purposes in another fee category are not also subject to the fees in this category. This exception does not apply if the radium sources are possessed for storage only.

⁸Licensees in this category are not assessed an annual fee because they are charged an annual fee in other categories while they are licensed to operate.

⁹Separate annual fees will not be assessed for pacemaker licenses issued to medical institutions who also hold nuclear medicine licenses under Categories 7.B. or 7.C.

¹⁰ Licensees paying fees under 7.B. are not subject to paying fees under 7.C. for broad scope license licenses issued under 420-3-25-.02 for human use of byproduct material, source material, and/or special nuclear material, except licenses for byproduct material, source material, or special nuclear material in sealed sources contained in teletherapy devices authorized on the same license.

¹¹Special projects means those requests submitted to the Agency for review for which fees are not otherwise specified in this schedule. Examples of special projects include, but are not limited to, topical report reviews, early site reviews, waste solidification facilities, route approvals for shipment of radioactive materials, and reviews of financial assurance submittals that do not require a license amendment.

¹²Licensees subject to fees paid under categories 3.C. & 7.C. are not subject to fees under 2.B. for possession and shielding authorized on the same license.

¹³There are no existing NRC licenses in these fee categories, therefore no annual fee is established by the NRC for these fee categories. Because no NRC annual fee is established, the licensee's annual fee for these categories is zero.
