



### SINGLE-MACHINE LICENSE INSTALLATIONS Machine-Specific Passwords

### **WINDOWS**

STEP 1: Run the installer on the DVD labeled "Wolfram Mathematica for Students 7 for Windows/Mac OS X/Linux x86".

**STEP 2:** You will be asked in which directory *Mathematica for Students* should be installed, which components to install, and if you want to have a shortcut created in the Start menu. At each screen, click Next to accept the defaults, or make any necessary changes and then click Next.

STEP 3: A summary of your settings will be displayed. Click Back to modify these settings. Click Install to start the installation.

STEP 4: After the files are copied to your hard drive, check the Launch Wolfram Mathematica box and click Finish. Mathematica for Students will start.

STEP 5: Select Single-Machine License in the password dialog box. Enter your name, organization name, and license number (exactly as it is given to you by your site administrator). Your license number is in the format Lxxxx-xxxx. Click OK.

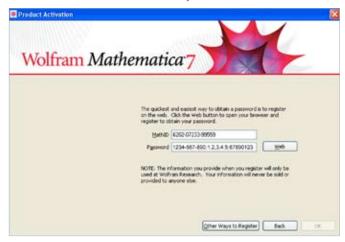


Your license number must be entered exactly as given to you by your site administrator. An example is shown here.

STEP 6: Your machine's MathID is displayed. Click Web to open your web browser and go to register.wolfram.com. Enter the license number and select I want to register a product and generate a password.

STEP 7: Enter your MathID number and contact information. After completing your registration, your password will be sent to you via email.

STEP 8: Enter your password in Mathematica for Students and click **OK**. Your password is in the format xxxx-xxx-xxx:x,x,x,x,x:x:xxxxxxxxx. Mathematica for Students is now ready for use.

### MAC OS X

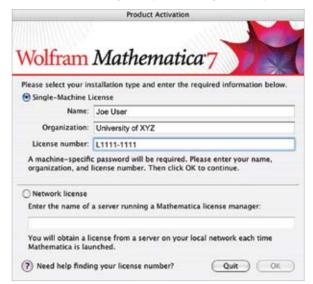
**STEP 1:** Insert the DVD labeled "Wolfram *Mathematica for Students* 7 for Windows/Mac OS X/Linux x86". A new window appears on your screen.

**STEP 2:** Drag the *Mathematica* icon from this window to the location on your hard drive where you want to install *Mathematica for Students*.

**STEP 3:** After the files are copied to your hard drive, double-click the *Mathematica* icon on your hard drive. *Mathematica for Students* will start.

**STEP 4:** Select **Single-Machine License** in the password dialog box. Enter your name, organization name, and license number (exactly as it is given to you by your site administrator). Your license number is in the format *Lxxxx-xxxx*. Click **OK**.

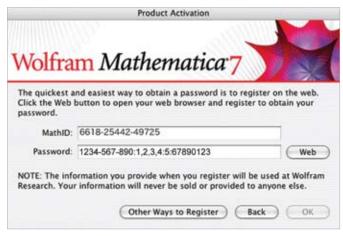
**STEP 5:** Your machine's MathID is displayed. Click **Web** to open your web browser and go to **register.wolfram.com**. Enter the license number and select I want to register a product and generate a password.



Your license number must be entered exactly as given to you by your site administrator. An example is shown here.

**STEP 6:** Enter your MathID number and contact information. After completing your registration, your password will be sent to you via email.

**STEP 7:** Enter your password in *Mathematica for Students* and click **OK**. Your password is in the format *xxxx-xxx-xxx:x,x,x,x:x:xxxxxxxxx*. *Mathematica for Students* is now ready for use.

# Machine-Specific Passwords

### **LINUX**

Note: To install Mathematica for Students on Linux, you may need root privileges.

**STEP 1:** Mount the DVD labeled "Wolfram Mathematica for Students 7 for Windows/Mac OS X/Linux x86".

**STEP 2:** Change the directory to /cdrom/Unix/Installer and type ./MathInstaller to run the installer.

Note: The exact location of the DVD mount point might be different for your platform.

**STEP 3:** Press **Enter** to accept the default installation directory for *Mathematica for Students*, or type in a new location and then press **Enter**.

**STEP 4:** After the files are copied to your hard drive, press **Enter** to accept the default location in which to copy the executable scripts, or type in a new location and then press **Enter**.

STEP 5: Type 1 to select Single-Machine License and press Enter.

**STEP 6:** Your machine name and MathID number are displayed. Go to **register.wolfram.com**, enter the license number (exactly as it is given to you by your site administrator), and select **I want to register a product and generate a password**. Your license number is in the format *Lxxxx-xxxx*.

**STEP 7:** Enter your MathID number and contact information to complete your registration. Your password will be sent to you via email. Your password is in the format xxxx-xxx-xxx:x,x,x,x:x:xxxxxxxxxx.

**STEP 8:** Enter your name, organization name, license number, and password. Press **Enter**. *Mathematica for Students* is now ready for use.

**NOTE:** If you do not have your password at the time of installation, quit the installer. When you are ready to enter your password, launch *Mathematica* and follow the steps below.



 Enter your name, organization name, and license number (exactly as it is given to you by your site administrator). Your license number is in the format Lxxxx-xxxx. Click OK.



 Your machine's MathID is displayed. Enter your password in Mathematica for Students and click OK. Your password is in the format xxxx-xxx-xxx:x,x,x,x:x:xxxxxxxxx. Mathematica for Students is now ready for use.
