Beaverton Arts Commission Seeks Outstanding Visual and Performing Arts Students For Scholarships - DEADLINE THIS MONDAY!

The Beaverton Arts Commission is now accepting applications for the Annual Art Student Scholarship Program for high school seniors. The deadline to apply is Monday, April 15.

To qualify, students must currently be in their senior year of high school. The following scholarships will be awarded:

- \$1,000 for Outstanding Visual Art High School Senior—includes traditional media, design and moving image.
- \$1,000 for Outstanding Performance Art High School Senior—includes music, dance, singing, and drama. Tech crew members can also apply.

More than one scholarship in each category may be given. Scholarships will be presented by Mayor Doyle at a Beaverton City Council meeting in June 2013. To fill out an application please visit www.BeavertonArts.org/AnnualArtScholarships.

The scholarships are funded in partnership by the Beaverton Arts Foundation and the Celebration of Creativity Committee of Southminster Presbyterian Church.

Carli Kruse to Demonstrate at Art On Broadway Gallery

Art On Broadway's monthly artist demonstration is by Carli Kruse, glass artist, who will show how she creates glass beads using the electroform process, at Art On Broadway, Sunday, April 21, 2013, from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm.

Kruse explains, "Electroforming is using electric current to place copper or other metals on objects. It is sort of like bronzing baby shoes! I place the bead in a solution along with copper anodes, and run electric current through the beaker. Where I have put a special copper paint, copper moves through the solution from the anodes to the bead, creating an organic application of copper on the surface of the bead." Art On Broadway's monthly Sunday demonstrations are free and open to the public and offer insight to the artist's creative process.

Located at 12570 SW Broadway Street, Beaverton, Oregon, Art On Broadway is within walking distance of the Max stop at Beaverton Round and just a few doors west of the Beaverton History Center.
