All undergraduate courses at McMaster have an enrolment capacity. The University is committed to making every effort to accommodate exchange students in courses offered at Level II or Level III; however, access to Level IV courses is often reserved for students registered in the final year of specialized programs at McMaster who require such courses to meet their degree requirements. Similar course reservations also apply to some 1st year courses. Courses offered in some programs, for example the Bachelor of Social Work and the Bachelor of Technology, are not available to students on exchange. Courses within the Faculty of Health Sciences and Department of Arts and Science are not open to exchange students. You must consult the Undergraduate Calendar to review the requisites of each course you wish to take.
