He is recognized internationally and has published over 140 papers and textbooks on project management. Presently, Dr. Kerzner is Senior Executive Director for Project Management for IIL. He is known for his work in the fields of project management, strategic planning and total quality management. Most notably he is recognized by PMI and IIL through the Kerzner Project Manager of the year award and PMI awards 4 scholarships per year in Dr. Kerzner's name for graduate studies in Project Management. Additionally, Baldwin-Wallace University has instituted the Kerzner Distinguished Lecturer Series in project management.

Dr. Kerzner will speak on the evolving landscape of project management and how managers can improve stakeholder management, understand the necessity for flexible project management methodologies and recognize and deal with the complex projects of the future.
