Submission Deadline: January 1-March 31

The Camille Alyse Begnaud Military Scholarship for Educational Advancement is awarded annually to retired, honorably discharged, active duty, or a member of the National Guard or Reserve. The scholarship is to provide financial assistance for service members, or veterans to aide in completing their educational goals without incurring excessive student loan debt. It's just another way to say "thank you" to those who deserve it the most.

Blinding the Application

All awards undergo blind review.

Candidates must submit 2 copies of documentation. One copy must be void of all identifying information from the application form and all accompanying documentation to ensure anonymity and fairness. An original of the application and supporting documents must be sent with one (1) blinded photocopy. The Scholarship Committee recommends that applicants retain a copy of submitted materials.

Submission Deadline

Applications must be received at the BSM of Louisiana Chapter 1 office by March 31, 2022, to be considered for the award. Submissions received after the deadline will not receive consideration. The Scholarship Committee recommends that applications be sent via registered certified mail or email. The Scholarship Committee is not responsible for non-performance on the part of the mail. No faxed copies will be accepted.

Scoring of Awards

Each award application will receive an identification number when received at the Chapter office. The application will then receive blind review based on an objective point system. It will be scored by Scholarship Committee members in conjunction with other appropriate reviewers.

Notification of Awards

The President of Blue Star Mothers of Louisiana Chapter 1 Big Dipper will notify applicants of the award selection no later than May 2022. Further instructions for the award recipients will be provided at that time.

Incomplete Applications

Incomplete submissions and applications will not be considered.

APPLICANTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP**

Eligibility Criteria

1. Be a resident of Louisiana.
2. Be retired, honorably discharged, active duty, or a member of the National Guard or Reserve.
3. Participate in, be accepted to or currently enrolled in an approved two or four Year College or technical/trade program or school at an accredited institution.
4. Must submit a complete, signed application, together with all supporting documents, by the deadline listed.

Award

1. Scholarship(s) of up to \$5,000 dollars will be awarded to qualified applicant(s) based on the number of candidate submissions each year and funding. Minimum scholarship award is \$1,000 dollars.
2. Applications will be accepted January 1 through March 31.
3. Scholarships will be awarded in June of the same calendar year.
4. Scholarships will be submitted to the individual after enrollment is verified.
5. It is asked that recipients attend the annual Red, Rock & Blue event to accept the award in person. Details will be provided at a later date.

Required Documentation

1. Complete application and one (1) blinded copy. 2 copies of all documentation must be submitted. One original and one blinded.
2. Submit a typed essay between 250-500 words addressing how you will use the scholarship funds to further your educational goals. Include one (1) blinded copy.
3. Active duty service-members must submit an email from your .mil account to verify your service. Emails will be sent to bsmscholarship@bluestarmoms.net.
4. Veterans service will be verified by the educational institution contact listed on the application.
5. Educational institution's contact information and student number.
6. Applications to be mailed or emailed only.
