Introduction

The Wolfgram Memorial Library subscribes to two (2) EBook collections:

- EBook Academic Collection
- EBSCO EBook Collection

Both collections and interdisciplinary and contain thousands of E-Books. Both collections are searched the same way.

Getting Started

- Begin from the Wolfgram Memorial Library homepage: http://www.widener.edu/wolfgram
- Click on Find Books
- Click on EBook Academic Collection or EBSCO EBook Collection

Searching for EBooks

• To search by Keywords: type in your keywords (for example: human trafficking) and then click on the search button.



• To search by Title: Type in the title of the EBook you are looking for. Change "Select a Field" to "Title" and then click on the search button.




 To search by Author: Type in the author's name and then change "Select a Field" to "Author." When finished, click on the search button.



EBook Detailed Record

- Once you have performed your search you get a list of results best matching your search criteria.
- Clicking on the title of one of the Ebooks in your results list takes you to the detailed record for that item.
- The detailed record gives you:
 - Title of the book
 - o Author/Editor's name
 - Publication information (publisher, place of publication, date)
 - o Applicable subject headings
 - o Image of the book's cover
 - o Table of Contents





EBook Viewer

To read the EBook online, click on the EBook Full Text link on the left side
of the detailed record




 If you are using a Mac, you will need to install a PDF Browser Plug-in in order to use the EBook Viewer. The plug-in can be found on the following website: http://www.schubert-it.com/pluginpdf/

Downloading an EBook

- Before downloading an EBook you need to do two things:
 - Sign up for a My EBSCOHost account (Click on "Sign In" in the upper right corner
 - o Download and install the appropriate viewing software:

- Desktop: Adobe® Digital Editions 1.7.1 or higher (http://www.adobe.com/products/digital-editions.html)
- Apple and Android devices: Bluefire Reader
 (http://www.bluefirereader.com/bluefire-reader.html)
- Kindle: PDFs can be created in the eBook Full Text view and transferred using Send To Kindle (http://o-support.epnet.com.libcat.widener.edu/knowledge_base/detail.ph
 p?id=6147)
- Once you have created and signed into the My EBSCOHost account and downloaded the appropriate viewing software, you can click on Download This EBook (Offline).




• In the pop-up window select the checkout period you want (maximum of 7 days) and then click on **Checkout and Download**.



Printing an EBook

- If you want to print out part of an EBook, you can do so by clicking on the EBook Full Text link and then using the print icon on the right side of the screen.
- NOTE: You will only be able to print 60 pages of the book at any one time.
