R- Restate

Turn the question or prompt into a statement. Use the words from the question or prompt to begin your answer.

<u>A-Answer</u>

Answer the question or prompt. Sometimes this is an inference and sometimes it's stated directly in the text.

C- Cite Evidence

Cite evidence from the text that supports your answer.

Use the following sentence starters:

- The author states...
- For example,
- For instance,
- According to <u>(title of text/book)</u>...
- The article points out that...
- In paragraph <u>(#)</u>...
- The text states...
- On page <u>(#)</u>, it says...

<u>E- Explain</u>

In your own words, explain how the evidence supports your answer.
