SUMMER SOLSTICE CELEBRATION

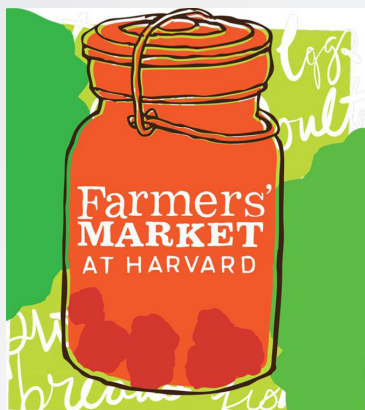
