- 1. **PLACEMENT EXAM** Students are encouraged to take the Language Placement Test from August 8 – August 30, 2016 if they have any experience in the language class they are interested in taking.
- 2. SUMMER STUDY ABROAD We currently have 8 projected summer study abroad programs planned for Argentina, China, France, Germany, India, Japan, Korea, and Spain. Students receive 6 Rice credit hours, and they may be eligible to receive scholarships to help them defray their costs to participate in these programs.
- 3. INTERNSHIPS Internships are available for students pursuing medical, business, education, and non-profit degrees.
- 4. **CERTIFICATE** CLIC offers a certificate to recognize high levels of communicative and interactional abilities in a second language. The requirements are posted online on our webpage (clic.rice.edu). The certificate will be recorded on the student's Rice transcripts.
