// UC vs. TULSA

The Bearcats and the Golden Hurricane enter their third season as rivals in the American Athletic Conference and have matched up five times in history with UC holding a slim 3-2 advantage in the series. Cincinnati scored a pair of 3-2 victories over Tulsa last season after splitting the two meetings in 2014.

// SCOUTING THE GOLDEN HURRICANE

Tulsa opened the season with a powerful 11-1 record and is riding a nine-match winning streak into its meeting with Cincinnati. Preseason All-Conference selection Erica Bohannon leads the team with 3.78 kills per set while libero Brooke Berryhill has a conference-high 5.48 digs per set.

// UC vs. SMU

Cincinnati has never beaten SMU in six tries, dating back to 2013. The Mustangs swept both matches last season and the Bearcats have never won more than a single set in a match against SMU.

// SCOUTING THE MUSTANGS

SMU enters the first conference weekend with a 7-5 record and like Cincinnati has played a tough schedule to open the 2016 slate, facing the likes of Arizona, N.C. State, TCU and North Carolina. The Mustangs lost reigning American Player and Setter of the Year, Avery Acker, but return reigning American Libero of the Year Morgan Heise who has recorded 5.44 digs per set to date. Janelle Giordano, a Preseason All-Conference selection, has 1.27 blocks per set to lead the team.

RANKINGS - TEAM

// TOUGH TESTS

If the only way to get better is to play good teams, the Bearcats did just that to open the 2016 schedule. After starting the year at Tennessee, Cincinnati faced a pair of teams receiving votes in the AVCA Top-25 Coaches Poll at the Shockers Volleyball Classic, beating Wichita State on its home floor. The schedule did not get any lighter at the Holiday Inn University Plaza Invitational when UC faced off against Michigan State (the first team receiving votes in the poll) and No. 23 Western Kentucky as well as a tough Southern Illinois team which was ranked No. 18 in the inaugural VolleyballMag.com mid-major poll.

// BEARCATS BLOCKERS

Cincinnati recorded 18.0 blocks in a 3-1 win over Middle Tennessee State on Aug. 27 at the DISH Tennessee Classic. The total was the most for any UC team since November 16, 2007, when it tallied 18.5 blocks in a 3-1 loss to Notre Dame. Alison Kimmel earned a career-high nine blocks while Maya Muldrow tied a career best with eight. Elly Ogle (six), Ciara Hill (six), Jordan Thompson (four) and Carly Nolan (three) also got in on the blocking action.

// PRESEASON PREFERENCE

Cincinnati was chosen as the American Athletic Conference Preseason Champion in a poll among the league's head coaches after receiving seven first-place votes and 96 total points on the ballot. It is the highest preseason finish for the Bearcats since joining The American in 2013 and the first time the team was selected as the preseason favorites since 2010 when it was a member of the BIG EAST Conference.

// THOMPSON TRIUMPHS

After being named the 2015 American Freshman of the Year, sophomore Jordan Thompson was picked as the conference's Preseason Player of the Year for the upcoming season. She also was a unanimous selection to the Preseason All-Conference team and was unanimously named First Team All-Conference last season. Thompson led the Bearcats in kills (459) and kills per set (3.92) in 2015 and earned a league-high nine weekly accolades, including three Offensive Player of the Week awards. She is the first UC volleyball player to be the Preseason Player of the Year since 2010 when Stephanie Niemer earned the title at the start of her All-American campaign.

// NOBLE NOLAN

Sophomore Carly Nolan also picked up preseason honors for the Bearcats, being named to the 14-person Preseason All-American Athletic Conference team. She was a First Team All-Conference performer in 2015 while recording 3.18 kills per set and 2.72 digs per set.

// NATIONAL DUTY

Two members of the Bearcats volleyball team were named to the U.S. Collegiate National Team which toured China this past summer. Thompson was selected to the 12-player roster while assistant coach Phillip White was picked as a member of the coaching staff. The squad, which was part of USA Volleyball's High Performance pipeline, trained and competed in a series of matches from June 18-July 1 in three different Chinese cities.

// YOUNG GUNS A BLAZIN'

All four members of the 2015 freshman class (Carly Nolan, Jordan Thompson, Jade Tingelhoff and Abby Williams) made considerable waves on the court during their first season at Cincinnati. Each of the four played in all 117 sets for the Bearcats and found themselves among the top-10 in the all-time freshman rankings in various categories.
