Manuscript publication fees are due after the galley proofs have been delivered by E-mail to the corresponding author. Authors receive a Page Charge Payment Form indicating the fees and options with the proofs. Manuscripts will be scheduled for publication after payment is received by the IAFP office.

JFP corresponding authors will be provided with a complimentary PDF of the published article by E-mail within the first week of publication. This PDF may be forwarded to co-authors.

JFP uses EzReprint, a user-friendly, automated online system to provide authors with the option to purchase paper reprints. Two weeks prior to publication, the corresponding author will receive an E-mail with a unique URL (SmartLink) and information about the reprint order process.

***Journal of Food Protection* Online Access Policy**

Full-text articles published by the *Journal of Food Protection* are published online via Ingenta Connect and may be accessed by subscribers or other readers who purchase the article for a fee. Full-text articles may not be released on other web sites (including PubMed) until 12-months after publication. In the case of authors whose research was supported by NIH or another funding agency with an open access mandate, the authors may deposit the final accepted manuscript on PubMed Central or a similar site as required by the agency for public release 12-months after publication. Permission to post the published article on other web sites (intranet and extranet only) must be obtained from IAFP through Copyright Clearance Center at copyright.com after the 12-month embargo period has expired.

Authors wishing to make their article available upon publication with immediate, unrestricted open access may pay an open access fee in lieu of page charges. Payment of the open access fee is required when the page charge fees are due prior to publication.
