

EMERITI FACULTY CIRCULATION POLICY

Emeriti Faculty of the University have the same borrowing privileges as guest patrons with the exception they are not charged a fee. Like all University patrons, emeriti faculty must complete an application in Manderino Library. Afterwards, each individual must go to the Information Desk in Natali Student Center where his/her picture is taken and a CalCard is issued, which is used as the library card. Replacement fees for lost CalCards are established by the CalCard office and those fees in existence at the time prevail. An emeriti faculty can borrow up to and including 25 items for a period of 21 days. Materials can be renewed once if not in demand by University faculty or students. Access to databases is not available to emeriti faculty from off-campus sites; however, they can be used on campus or in the library.
