**Bear Transit Shuttles**  
Bear Transit is UC Berkeley's shuttle system, servicing the campus and vicinity.  
Anyone can ride Bear Transit shuttles, which provide convenient daytime and nighttime (Night Safety Shuttle) transportation between north and south sides of campus, Downtown Berkeley BART, parking lots, Clark Kerr campus, the Hill area, residence halls, Berkeley Global Campus at Richmond Bay and Campus Shared Services on 4th Street. **Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory Shuttles**  
The Laboratory provides (orange route and blue route) shuttle bus services, Monday-Friday, daytime through early evening. Routes run throughout its 200-acre facility, downtown Berkeley, local off-site facilities, UC Campus, Downtown Berkeley BART and Rockridge BART stations.
