**Faculty salary comparison** is based on the AAUP faculty salary survey. The four public comparison institutions are Illinois, Michigan, University at Buffalo and Virginia; the four private institutions are Harvard, MIT, Stanford, and Yale. The Comp 8 (comparison 8) is the midpoint between the average of the public comparison four and the average of the private comparison four. **(5.2.1)**
