**Spring:** Completed *Graduation Application* forms are due no later than February 15th.

Summer: Completed Graduation Application forms are due no later than June 15th.

Fall: Completed Graduation Application forms are due no later than September 15th.

Graduation Information Students expecting to complete work for their degree must declare their candidacy by filing a Graduation Application with the Office of the Registrar for the semester in which they plan to receive the degree. If you wish to change your name you must file a Name Change (along with documentation of your new name) with the Office of the Registrar. Moving between any other terms will require notifying the Office of the Registrar using this online form found here. Filing a Graduation Application with an outstanding Incomplete grade on your record or with outstanding transfer work may prevent degree conferral, and you will be required to re-file for a later term.

Commencement Participation Graduate students may participate in two ceremonies if masters and doctoral degrees are conferred in separate years. Indicate which ceremony you plan to attend, if any, on this form. Participating in Commencement does not indicate confirmation that degree requirements have been fulfilled.
