The School

Mount Notre Dame is an archdiocesan regional high school in suburban Cincinnati serving approximately 700 young women in grades nine through twelve. It is accredited by the North Central Association of Secondary Schools and the Ohio Catholic School Accrediting Association, and chartered by the Department of Education, State of Ohio. Our students come from over 80 different grade schools. MND is a one-to-one Tablet PC school. 99.44% of our 2015 graduates are pursuing bachelor's degrees.

Grading and Class Standing

All students have both an unweighted and weighted GPA, which are calculated at the end of each semester. Unweighted GPA is based on a student's scholastic average. Weighted GPA is based on a student's quality point average. MND does not report class rank on our official school transcript. Quality points are determined as follows:
