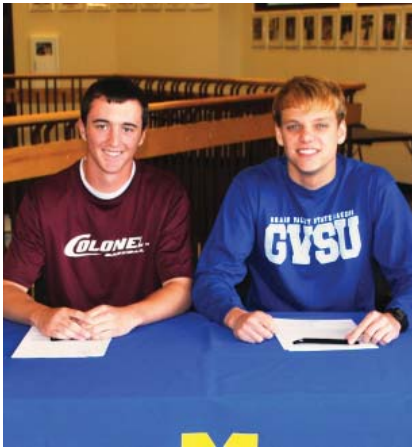

Class of 2012 Accomplishment Highlights

- The Class of 2012 will attend 45 different colleges in 15 different states and two countries
- Nearly \$3 million in merit scholarship offers came from many different colleges and independent sources
- 46 of the 101 graduates were offered college-sponsored merit scholarships
- The University of Cincinnati and its regional campuses claim the most 2012 MHS graduates, followed by The Ohio State University and Miami University (tied)
- Students were offered admission at 95 different colleges
- 10 graduates have been accepted into an Honors Program at the universities where they will attend
- Nine graduates will be attending college at institutions that offer admission to fewer than 50% of their applicants, including Colorado College, Davidson College, McGill University, Northwestern University, Stanford University, University of Michigan, University of Rochester, University of Virginia and Wake Forest University.
- The Class of 2012 sent 375 applications for college admission
- 21 seniors were inducted into the Cum Laude Society
- Honors Diplomas from the state of Ohio were awarded to 44 seniors
- 39 seniors earned the “President’s Award for Education Excellence”
- 41 seniors were members of the National Honor Society
- Two seniors were named “Finalists” by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation
- Six seniors were named “Commended Students” by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation
- 50 seniors earned the “Award of Merit” from the Ohio Department of Education
- 47 seniors took one or more AP exams this spring
- 92% of 2012 graduates plan to attend college right away in the fall of 2012; 8% will either enter the workforce, join the U.S. Military, take a year off, or are undecided about future plans
- Organizations within the Mariemont High School community awarded 45 scholarships to graduates
- Many memorial scholarships were offered this year - with coordination assistance from the Mariemont School Foundation: Robert D. Threlkeld Memorial Scholarship, David Deeters Memorial, Julia Donnelly Memorial, Damien Jahnigan Memorial, Don F. Mahan Memorial, Robert A. Martin Memorial, Wanda McNeal Memorial, John M. Lucas/Virmorgan L. Ziegler Memorial and “Let Us Never Forget” scholarship in memory of Cpt. Tyler Swisher
- The Kiwanis Club awarded two new educational grants this spring. Combined with the ongoing college students supported by the club, Kiwanis is currently making a difference in the educational lives of five Mariemont HS graduates
- Mariemont High School enjoyed hosting exchange student Julia Ayerbe from Columbia this year. Her host family was the Bartletts of Mariemont.
- 11 graduates of the Class of 2012 plan to participate in college-level sports at their chosen university

Students in the Class of 2012 were offered nearly \$3 million in merit-based scholarships

As we celebrate a truly successful 2011-2012 school year, there is no time to rest on our laurels. We have been packing, moving and planning ahead for exciting changes and updates in our district – all designed to better serve our students and communities now and well into the future.

NEW ADDRESSES – The Mariemont City School District is changing the name of the lane where Mariemont High School is located. While the lane actually veers off the main Pocahontas Ave, it had maintained the Pocahontas name. As of June 1, Mariemont High School and the newly relocated Board of Education office (at back of MHS) are residents of Warrior Way: **Mariemont High School - 1 Warrior Way, Mariemont Board of Education - 2 Warrior Way.**

UPDATED WARRIOR IMAGE – At their April 24 meeting, the Mariemont Board of Education adopted an official Mariemont Warrior logo for our district mascot. The strong, determined Warrior will grace all official athletic uniforms and gear and will be available for spirit wear use beginning Fall 2012 using a district style guide. NEW DISTRICT WEBSITE – This summer the District is introducing a completely revamped website. Be sure to visit and explore the information offered there. NEW: My Mariemont Portal will offer students, staff and parents customized accounts for classroom work, resources, and specific school/district information via Blackboard learning management systems.

2012-2013 TECHNOLOGY PLAN – At their May 15 meeting, the Board of Education approved a one-to-one technology plan for grades 2-12. One-to-one technology simply means that every student in grades 2-12 will have a laptop or iPad in each classroom every day. Students in grades K and 1 will continue to utilize district laptop carts within their classrooms. The overall plan is to provide an opportunity for our students to participate in a Bring Your Own Technology program or use a school laptop partially paid for through school fees.
