

## **RWTH International Academy – Fellowship for Turkish Engineers**

### *Supplementary Scholarship for Holders of the Joint Master Scholarship DAAD-TEV, Turkey*

#### Preamble

This scholarship intends to support highly qualified engineering students from Turkey to pursue a Master's degree programme at the RWTH Aachen University via the organization of the RWTH International Academy. It is intended to supplement scholarship holders of the DAAD-TEV scholarship programme for Turkish students, and allows a waiver of the tuition fees charged by the RWTH International Academy. This fellowship applies to admitted students at the RWTH Aachen University in one of the following Master's degree programme:

- (1) M. Sc. Computer Aided Conception and Production in Mechanical Engineering,
- (2) M. Sc. Management and Engineering in Computer Aided Mechanical Engineering,
- (3) M. Sc. Management and Engineering in Design Concepts and Structural Engineering of Industrial Facilities,
- (4) M. Sc. Management and Engineering in Electrical Power Systems,
- (5) M. Sc. Management and Engineering in Production Systems,
- (6) M. Sc. Management and Engineering in Water,
- (7) M. Sc. Production Systems Engineering,
- (8) M. Sc. Textile Engineering.

#### § 1 Principles

The scholarship covers the tuition fees for the respective Master's degree programme (within the regular study duration) between 13,500.00 EUR and 22,000.00 EUR, depending on the programme. An administrative fee of 500.00 EUR per semester will be charged from the student.

#### § 2 Requirements

Admitted students of the programmes mentioned above, with Turkish citizenship, who have performed excellent in their bachelor studies and have already been awarded the DAAD-TEV scholarship.

#### § 3 Duration

The scholarship lasts three or four semesters (depending on the regular study period of the programme).

#### § 4 Registration Process and Application Deadline

The application for the scholarship has to be handed in together with the regular application for the master's programme (the deadline for the master's programme application is 1 March of each year). Admitted students of one of the above mentioned programmes who completed the application for the scholarship are eligible to receive funding. Application deadline for the scholarship is 1 March of each year. The required documents are:

- Filled application sheet 'Fellowship for Turkish Engineers',
- Regular application for the M.Sc. programme,
- Copy of DAAD-TEV agreement (as soon as the applicant receives it).

#### § 5 Escape clause

The awarding of this scholarship is dependent on the availability of the financial capital of the RWTH International Academy student fund. There is no legal basis for students to demand the scholarship.
