

**[\_] Matthew 18:19-20** – <sup>19</sup>“Again, I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything you ask for, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven. <sup>20</sup>For where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them.” (Agreement)

**[\_] Matthew 18:21-22** -- <sup>21</sup>Then Peter came to Jesus and asked, “Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother when he sins against me? Up to seven times?” <sup>22</sup>Jesus answered, “I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times.” (Forgiving your brother)

**[\_] Matthew 19:16-17** -- <sup>16</sup>Now a man came up to Jesus and asked, “Teacher, what good thing must I do to get eternal life?” <sup>17</sup>“Why do you ask me about what is good?” Jesus replied. “There is only One who is good. If you want to enter life, obey the commandments.” (Eternal life)

**[\_] Matthew 6:14-15** – <sup>14</sup>“For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. <sup>15</sup>But if you do not forgive men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.” (Forgive men)

**[\_] Mark 11:25-26** – <sup>25</sup>“And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive him, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins. <sup>26</sup>But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your sins.” (Pray without grudges)

**[\_] Romans 12:18-19** -- <sup>18</sup>If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. <sup>19</sup>Do not take revenge, my friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: “It is mine to avenge; I will repay,” says the Lord. (Live at peace)

**[\_] John 15:7** – <sup>7</sup>“If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.” (Jesus in your heart)

**[\_] Romans 10:17** -- <sup>17</sup>Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ. (Faith)

**[\_] Philippians 4:6-7** -- <sup>6</sup>Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. <sup>7</sup>And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. (Anxiety)

**[\_] John 6:44** – <sup>44</sup>“No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day” (Father draws him)

**[\_] John 15:2** – <sup>2</sup>“He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful.” (Bearing fruit)

**[\_] Proverbs 3:5-6** -- <sup>5</sup>Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; <sup>6</sup>in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight. (Trust)

**[\_] Luke 10:19-20** – <sup>19</sup>“I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you. <sup>20</sup>However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.” (Authority)

**[\_] James 1:5-8** -- <sup>5</sup>If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him. <sup>6</sup>But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. <sup>7</sup>That man should not think he will receive anything from the Lord; <sup>8</sup>he is a double-minded man, unstable in all he does. (Wisdom)

**[\_] Matthew 6:33** – <sup>33</sup>“But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.” (Seek)

**[\_] John 14:12** – <sup>12</sup>“I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.” (Do what Jesus does)

**[\_] John 14:13-14** – <sup>13</sup>“And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father. <sup>14</sup>You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it.” (Ask/Glory)

**[\_] John 20:23** – <sup>23</sup>“If you forgive anyone his sins, they are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven.” (Sins)

**[\_] Romans 8:28** -- <sup>28</sup>And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. (God works)

**[\_] Galatians 3:13** -- <sup>13</sup>Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: “Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree. <sup>14</sup>He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.” (Curses)

**[\_] Mark 16:17-18** -- <sup>17</sup>“And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; <sup>18</sup>they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well.” (Signs of believers)

**[\_] John 16:23-24** -- <sup>23</sup>“In that day you will no longer ask me anything. I tell you the truth, my Father will give you whatever you ask in my name. <sup>24</sup>Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.”

**[\_] Isaiah 53:4-5** -- <sup>4</sup>Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. <sup>5</sup> But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.

**[\_] Matthew 8:16-17** -- <sup>16</sup>When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick. <sup>17</sup>This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: “He took up our infirmities and carried our diseases.”

**[\_] Philippians 2:14-16** -- <sup>14</sup>Do everything without complaining or arguing, <sup>15</sup>so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like stars in the universe <sup>16</sup>as you hold out the word of life—in order that I may boast on the day of Christ that I did not run or labor for nothing.

**[\_] Psalm 139:23-24** -- <sup>23</sup> Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. <sup>24</sup> See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

**[\_] James 4:6-8** -- <sup>6</sup>But he gives us more grace. That is why Scripture says: “God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.” <sup>7</sup>Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. <sup>8</sup>Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

**[\_] Romans 3:23** -- <sup>22</sup>This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference, <sup>23</sup>for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, <sup>24</sup>and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.

[\_] **Mark 11:22-24** – <sup>22</sup>“Have faith in God,” Jesus answered. <sup>23</sup>“I tell you the truth, if anyone says to this mountain, ‘Go, throw yourself into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart but believes that what he says will happen, it will be done for him. <sup>24</sup>Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.”

[\_] **Proverbs 3:7-8** -- <sup>7</sup>Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD and shun evil. <sup>8</sup>This will bring health to your body and nourishment to your bones.

[\_] **Matthew 22:37-39** -- <sup>37</sup>Jesus replied: “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ <sup>38</sup>This is the first and greatest commandment. <sup>39</sup>And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’”

[\_] **Isaiah 55:8-9** – <sup>8</sup>“For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways,” declares the LORD. <sup>9</sup>“As the heavens are higher than the Earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.”

[\_] **1 Corinthians 13:4-8** -- <sup>4</sup>Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. <sup>5</sup>It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. <sup>6</sup>Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. <sup>7</sup>It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. <sup>8</sup>Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away.

[\_] **Job 33:14-18** -- <sup>14</sup>For God does speak—now one way, now another—though men may not perceive it. <sup>15</sup>In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falls on men as they slumber in their beds, <sup>16</sup>he may speak in their ears and terrify them with warnings, <sup>17</sup>to turn man from wrongdoing and keep him from pride, <sup>18</sup>to preserve his soul from the pit, his life from perishing by the sword.

[\_] **John 3:16-18** – <sup>16</sup>“For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. <sup>17</sup>For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. <sup>18</sup>Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.”

[\_] **Psalm 119:9** -- <sup>9</sup>How can a young man keep his way pure? By living according to your word.

[\_] **John 14:6** -- <sup>6</sup>Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

[\_] **John 14:2-4** -- <sup>2</sup>"In my Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you. <sup>3</sup>And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am. <sup>4</sup>You know the way to the place where I am going."

[\_] **John 3:3** -- <sup>3</sup>In reply Jesus declared, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again."

[\_] **John 3:5** -- <sup>5</sup>Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit."

[\_] **Matthew 6:19-21** -- <sup>19</sup>"Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. <sup>20</sup>But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. <sup>21</sup>For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

[\_] **Matthew 6:22-23** -- <sup>22</sup>"The eye is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are good, your whole body will be full of light. <sup>23</sup>But if your eyes are bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light within you is darkness, how great is that darkness!"

[\_] **Matthew 18:18** -- <sup>18</sup>"I tell you the truth, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

[\_] **John 6:35** -- <sup>35</sup>Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty."

[\_] **John 8:12** -- <sup>12</sup>When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

**[\_] John 14:23-24 --** <sup>23</sup>Jesus replied, "If anyone loves me, he will obey my teaching. My Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. <sup>24</sup>He who does not love me will not obey my teaching. These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me."

**[\_] Matthew 7:1-2 --** <sup>1</sup>"Do not judge, or you too will be judged. <sup>2</sup>For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."

**[\_] Matthew 6:9-14 -- (The Lord's Prayer)** <sup>9</sup>"This, then, is how you should pray: " 'Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, <sup>10</sup>your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. <sup>11</sup>Give us today our daily bread. <sup>12</sup>Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. <sup>13</sup>And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.' "

**[\_] Psalm 23:1-6 (The 23<sup>rd</sup> Psalm)**

<sup>1</sup> The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not be in want.

<sup>2</sup> He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters,

<sup>3</sup> he restores my soul. He guides me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

<sup>4</sup> Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

<sup>5</sup> You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.

<sup>6</sup> Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

**[\_] Matthew 5:3-12 (The Beatitudes AKA Sermon on the Mount)**

<sup>3</sup>"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

<sup>4</sup>"Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.

<sup>5</sup>"Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.

<sup>6</sup>"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.

<sup>7</sup>"Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.

<sup>8</sup>"Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.

<sup>9</sup>"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God.

<sup>10</sup>"Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

<sup>11</sup>"Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. <sup>12</sup>Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you."

**[\_] Exodus 20:3-17 (The Ten Commandments)**

<sup>3</sup> "You shall have no other gods before me.

<sup>4</sup> "You shall not make for yourself an idol in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. <sup>5</sup> You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, <sup>6</sup> but showing love to a thousand {generations} of those who love me and keep my commandments.

<sup>7</sup> "You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God, for the LORD will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.

<sup>8</sup> "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. <sup>9</sup> Six days you shall labor and do all your work, <sup>10</sup> but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your manservant or maidservant, nor your animals, nor the alien within your gates. <sup>11</sup> For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

<sup>12</sup> "Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you.

<sup>13</sup> "You shall not murder.

<sup>14</sup> "You shall not commit adultery.

<sup>15</sup> "You shall not steal.

<sup>16</sup> "You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

<sup>17</sup> "You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."

**[\_] Ecclesiastes 3:1-8**

<sup>1</sup> There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven:

<sup>2</sup> a time to be born and a time to die, a time to plant and a time to uproot,

<sup>3</sup> a time to kill and a time to heal, a time to tear down and a time to build,

<sup>4</sup> a time to weep and a time to laugh, a time to mourn and a time to dance,

<sup>5</sup> a time to scatter stones and a time to gather them, a time to embrace and a time to refrain,

<sup>6</sup> a time to search and a time to give up, a time to keep and a time to throw away,

<sup>7</sup> a time to tear and a time to mend, a time to be silent and a time to speak,

<sup>8</sup> a time to love and a time to hate, a time for war and a time for peace.

**[\_] Psalm 91:1-16**

<sup>1</sup> He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.

<sup>2</sup> I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

<sup>3</sup> Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence.

<sup>4</sup> He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.

<sup>5</sup> You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day,

<sup>6</sup> nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday.

<sup>7</sup> A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.

<sup>8</sup> You will only observe with your eyes and see the punishment of the wicked.

<sup>9</sup> If you make the Most High your dwelling — even the LORD, who is my refuge—

<sup>10</sup> then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent.

<sup>11</sup> For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways;

<sup>12</sup> they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.

<sup>13</sup> You will tread upon the lion and the cobra; you will trample the great lion and the serpent.

<sup>14</sup> "Because he loves me," says the LORD, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.

<sup>15</sup> "He will call upon me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him.

<sup>16</sup> "With long life will I satisfy him and show him my salvation."
