Note pad has location of where you are spinning, including nearest cross roads, to help direct emergency services if required.	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Note pad has full name of fire spinner/s their emergency contacts (family and doctor) and any existing medical conditions	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
First Aid kit has items suitable for burns. Open and check contents	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Fueling can. Has lid, clean, no holes or rust	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Damp 100% cotton towel to be used by safety person, free of frays and debris (not to be used for blotting excess fuel)	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
A separate 100% cotton towel and plastic bag for blotting excess fuel (if using blotting method)	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Fire extinguisher is free of debris with pin intact	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Fire extinguisher pressure gauge is displaying full and expiry date is good	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Fire extinguisher has no dents or corrosion	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Suitable fuel container is clearly marked and has "child proof" safety cap	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Fuel container has no rust or damage	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Fuel MSDS (Material Safety Data Sheet) available and on site	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Fire spinner has read and understands MSDS	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Fire Blanket or Military wool blanket is free of frays, holes and debris	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Fire Blanket or Military wool blanket has no residual fuel	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Flashlight has good batteries	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>

<b>Fire tool equipment check</b>	
Quick links are tightened with pliers/spanner	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Metal parts free from rust/corrosion	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Metal parts and handles cleaned of any residual fuel	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Screws are tight and secure	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Link chains pulled and checked for strength	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Handle stitching is pulled to confirm strength	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Stitching on wicks are secure	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
Wicking is in good condition	Checked <input type="checkbox"/>
