Procurement Services is excited to introduce an initiative to enhance TechMart to become Caltech's integrated Procure-To-Pay (P2P) platform.

This initiative will bridge Purchasing and Accounts Payable, making purchasing and related accounting transactions available in TechMart, as a single platform. We are embarking on this P2P initiative to eliminate paper forms, align purchasing and payable practices with Caltech goals, and most importantly, to save Campus divisions/ departments time and effort. As part of this initiative, Procurement Services has engaged Campus stakeholders from all academic divisions and various administrative departments to assist in the implementation process. P2P is anticipated to go live April 2018. Please check back for more information.

Travel Services



In 2005, Congress passed The REAL ID Act, which established minimum security standards for state-issued driver's licenses and identification. If states do not meet these standards, federal agencies, like TSA, are prohibited from accepting licenses and identification cards for official purposes.

Beginning October 1, 2020, every traveler will need a REAL IDcompliant license, state ID, or another acceptable form of identification (i.e. passport) to fly within the U.S (domestic air travel).

California is a compliant state, due to an extension. You may continue to use your state-issued driver's license or ID to fly in the U.S. until October 10, 2018.


