Session III

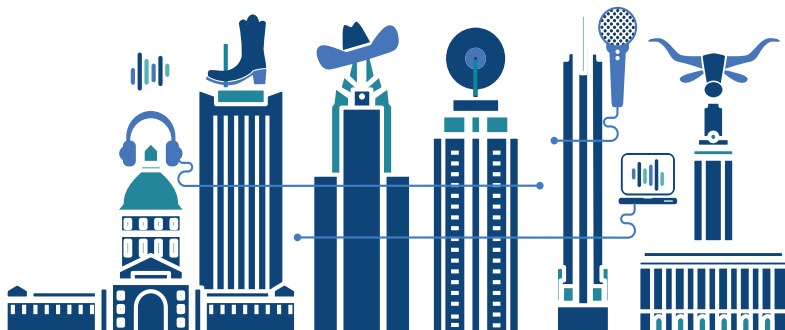
Changes in Pedagogy and Technology
