## Sample Library 10 evaluation question

Search the Mission College Online Library Catalog for one book that could help you with the following research question. The book must be appropriate for academic research.

**What factors made it difficult for Lincoln to issue the Emancipation Proclamation even though he was personally against slavery?**

Explain why you consider this book appropriate for your research based on authority, accuracy, and content.

**Keyword search:** lincoln AND emancipation

### Sample Library 10 evaluation answer

**Authority** – The author of this book is an authority. I did a Google search and found that he is a professor in the Department of History at Columbia University.

**Accuracy** – This book includes a bibliography so the sources can be checked.

**Content** – I know this book is about my topic because the subjects indicate that it is about Lincoln's views on slavery and emancipation.

### Unacceptable evaluation answers

- I can clearly identify the author.
- The book is a best seller.
- The content of the book is blatant and can be seen just by reading the title.

### Incomplete evaluation answers

- The author is an expert in his field.
- The publisher has authority.
- I can tell this book is about my topic from the subject.

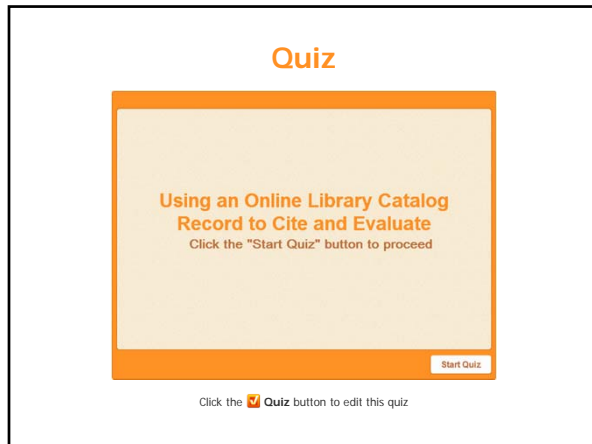

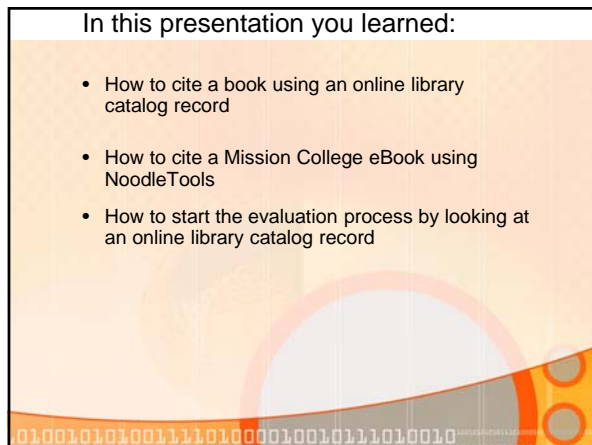
