

## **Social Security opportunities: (from the Social Security Administration website: [www.ssa.gov](http://www.ssa.gov) )**

SSA offers opportunities for students to expand their work experience and build upon their academic skills. Student programs are open to students in academic, technical, or vocational programs.

### *Volunteer Internship Program (VIP)*

Student volunteers are given educationally-related work assignments to supplement their academic studies. Internships can earn academic credit(s) based on the school's program requirements. Normally, volunteer internships do not exceed one semester or quarter, however, extensions may be approved based on academic requirements. A written internship agreement outlines assignments and projects. To apply, send your cover letter, resume, and unofficial transcript to [dchr.seep@ssa.gov](mailto:dchr.seep@ssa.gov).

### *Pathways Internship Program*

This program is for current students enrolled in a wide variety of educational institutions from high school to graduate level. It provides students with paid opportunities to work in agencies and explore Federal careers while still in school. After completion of the program, interns may be converted to a permanent position. ### *Pathways Recent Graduates Program*

This program is for individuals who have recently graduated from qualifying educational institutions or programs and seek a dynamic, career development program with training and mentorship. To be eligible, applicants must apply within two years of degree or certificate completion (except for veterans precluded from doing so due to their military service obligation; they will have up to six years to apply).

Participants receive customized training and development opportunities throughout the program. Each participant receives mentorship, formal and interactive training, and individual development plans. Positions within this program offer opportunities for career advancement.
