## IVGID PUBLIC WORKS HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE AND E-WASTE PROGRAMS PROTECT LAKE TAHOE

Protecting Lake Tahoe's outstanding water quality and beautiful natural environment is a key mission of the IVGID Public Works Department. The District's Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) and Electronic Waste (E-Waste) Drop-off Program is staffed by the Waste Not division. All Waste Not staff have been properly trained to handle the variety of materials being collected at our site. The program has provided a convenient way for residents to properly dispose of hazardous materials since 2002.

Most items collected fall into the categories of flammable, toxic or corrosive. These materials should never be flushed down the toilet, poured down the drain or placed into a dumpster or trash can. Batteries, televisions, and other electronics contain heavy metals which should never go into a landfill.

In 2014, the operation serviced an estimated 2,000 customers and diverted 70+ tons of HHW and E-waste from the landfill. The program provides a vital service in the prevention of illegal dumping into the sewer system and in community green space. This is the only "one-stop-drop-off" combined HHW/E-Waste site in Nevada; with most items being accepted for free (only televisions have a fee) from residents. Other residents in the state need to go to multiple locations to properly dispose of their items and there are fees for disposal of most items.

The program is funded by the franchise fees on solid waste services. The collection site is staffed an average of 600+ hours, annually. The HHW and E-Waste materials are removed monthly by certified processors which has an annual average cost of \$65,000. The reuse portion of the E-Waste program does not have a materials recycling charge, but staff drives the materials to Computer Corps' recycling center in the Carson Valley. This program is one example of Public Works' commitment to provide excellent service for our residents and stewardship of our resources.

## **\$150 BEAR BOX REBATES AVAILABLE**

**\$150 rebates are available for Single Family and Multi-Family Homes (without dumpster trash service) when purchased from and installed by an approved metal bear box vendor.**

1. Submit application to IVGID Waste Not prior to installation
2. IVGID Waste Not staff is available to help identify an approved installation location
3. Provide proof of payment for completed bear box installation within 60 days of filing the rebate
4. IVGID Waste Not staff will verify site installation
5. IVGID Public Works will credit \$150 to customer's account
