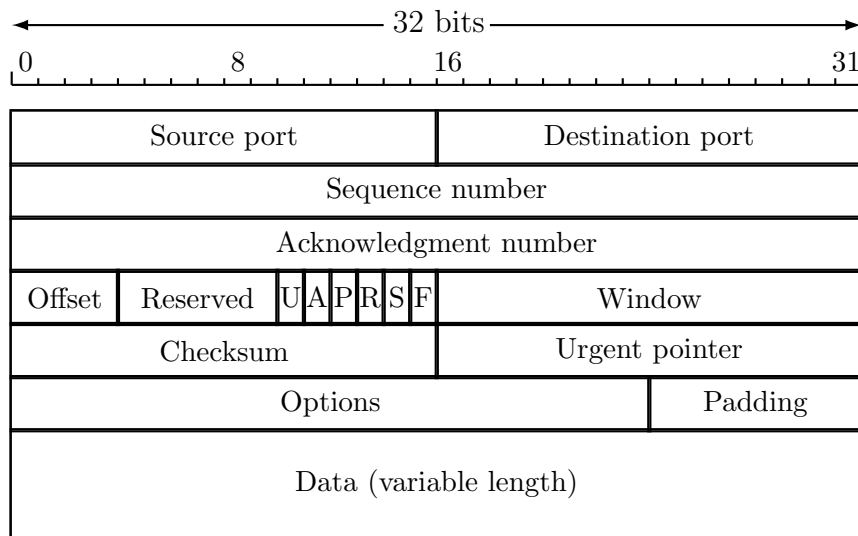


Figure 8.3 TCP header

4. Page 229, Figure 8.3: The TCP header is missing the “Acknowledgment number” field. The corrected version is as follows:

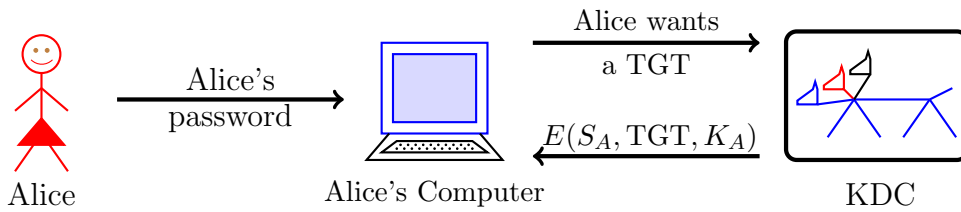


Figure 10.20 Kerberized login

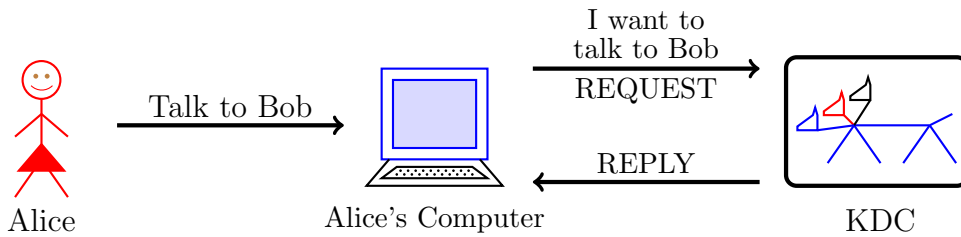


Figure 10.21 Alice gets TicketToBob

5. Page 317, Figures 10.20 and 10.21: In both of these figures, the right-hand side should be the KDC, not Bob. The corrected versions are given here.
