

## Part II, Final Project

As mentioned in an email to the class and several times during class, you were required to include a short (2-3 sentence) summary of your research question.

- 19= 95%
  - very clear research goals in your summary [had to be included]
  - entries are detailed, critical, and relate all readings to research goals
  - choice of additional readings shows broad understanding of topic
  - no grammar mistakes, citation errors
  
- 18= 90%
  - clear research goals in your summary
  - entries are detailed, critical, and generally relate readings to research goals
  - choice of additional readings shows good understanding of topic
  - minimal grammar mistakes, citation errors
  - 5% deduction if you forgot your summary (unless clearly incorporated into an entry)
  
- 17=85%
  - research goals given in your summary
  - entries give some detail, some critique, and may not be as clearly linked to research goals
  - choice of additional readings shows understanding of topic, could be more well developed
  - some grammar mistakes, citation errors
  - 5% deduction if you forgot your summary
  
- 16=80%
  - research summary not well constructed
  - entries are not detailed, uncritical, and may not be linked to research goals
  - choice of additional readings shows basic understanding of topic, needs significant development
  - grammar mistakes, citation errors
  - 5% deduction if you forgot your summary
