

- *Design Your Future: A Student's Guide to Careers* is a student E-Resource intended to support student learning throughout all stages of the co-operative education (co-op) course: the pre-placement instruction required before students enter a co-op placement, the ongoing instruction while students are on their placement and when students return to the classroom after the completion of their placement.
- *Design Your Future* is a supportive resource for all students exploring careers. Throughout the E-Resource, opportunities for learning are suggested that can be applied or reflected on in many courses.
