Ctrl+B

Combine with	the Shift key to select text.
Shift+Left or Right Arrow Keys	Select characters one at a time.
Shift+Up or Down Arrow Keys	Select lines one at a time.
Shift+Ctrl+Lef t or Right Arrow Key	Select words – keep pressing the arrow keys to select additional words.
Shift+Ctrl+Up or Down Arrow Keys	Select paragraphs.
Shift+Home	Select the text between the cursor and the beginning of the current line.
Shift+End	Select the text between the cursor and the end of the current line.
Shift+Ctrl+Ho me	Select the text between the cursor and the beginning of the text entry field.
Shift+Ctrl+En	Select the text between the cursor and the end of the text entry field.
Shift+Page Down	Select a frame of text below the cursor.
Shift+Page Up	Select a frame of text above the cursor.
Ctrl+A	Select all text.
You can use several of these shortcuts to fine-	

You can use several of these shortcuts to finetine your selected text. For example, you could press Shift+End to select the text to the end of the current line, and then press Shift+Down to also select the line below it.

After selecting text, you can start typing immediately to replace the text - you don't have to press Delete first.
