



SURVEY ON POLICE REFORM AND REINVENTION


The size of the police forces varies by each responding municipality.





Q4 How many police officers reside within your municipality?





Q5 Are there any police officer vacancies within the police department?







Q7 Does your police department currently have accreditation from the New York State Law Enforcement Agency Accreditation Council?





Q8 If no, has your department adopted the "Critical Standards" set by the New York State Law Enforcement Agency Accreditation Council?










Q12 Does your police department incorporate Implicit Bias Awareness Training into its in-service training requirements for police officers?


Q13 Does your police department incorporate De-escalation Training into its in-service training and procedural requirements for police officers?


Q14 Which of the following types of equipment/resources does your police department possess? (Select all that apply)









Q16 If yes, please describe the purposes for which you use such funds?




Q17 Do you incorporate a psychological examination as part of your new police hire recruitment program?





Q19 Do you require new police recruits to successfully pass a polygraph examination as a condition of employment?





Q26 Does your police department currently have a body-worn camera program?





Q27 If yes, are all officers required to wear and have the camera on when on duty?















Q38 To what degree do the police officers of your police department 'moonlight' (take on secondary employment)?





Q41 To what degree does your police department have access to social service professionals to seek guidance or referrals of individuals with immediate needs?






