White Greasepaint Recipe

2 Tablespoons shortening

1 teaspoon flour

5 teaspoons cornstarch

- Mix together in a small bowl.
- Add a small dab of Vaseline and mix.
- Store, covered, at room temperature.

To create colored face paint, gradually add drops of food coloring until you get the desired color.

To apply makeup: Always make sure your face is clean and dry before applying makeup. Using a lotion or face cream first helps remove makeup more easily.

Use your fingers, a makeup sponge, or a brush to apply.

Use a light dusting of powder to set the makeup so it doesn't smear.

To remove makeup: wipe excess makeup off with tissue or paper towel. Scrub your face with soap and water. Use a cold cream to remove any lingering makeup.
